About IQAC

IQAC is formed and approved by the Governing body to take care of quality assurance strategies for the Institute's long-term quality standards. The establishment of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) is a crucial step in ensuring effective planning, guidance, and monitoring of strategic benchmarks for various academic and administrative tasks. It serves as the nodal agency in the institution for coordinating quality-improving initiatives, such as the adoption and promotion of best practices.

Goal:

IQAC aims to create a structure for deliberate, persistent, and catalytic action to enhance the administrative and academic performance of the institution by internalizing a quality culture and institutionalizing the best practices.

Strategies:

The IQAC will develop, monitor, and control the below procedures to achieve its goals:

- a) timely, efficient, and progressive performance of academic, administrative, and financial tasks;
- b) Societal relevance of academic and research programs;
- c) equitable access to and affordability of academic programs for different sections of society;
- d) optimization and integration of modern teaching and learning methods;
- e) validation of evaluation procedures; and
- f) adequacy, maintenance, and upgradation of infrastructural facilities.
