Sir, explained the role of IPA in organising World Pharmacist's Day on 25th September every year to impart awareness of pharmacy profession in the country. National Pharmacy week celebrations were also conducted in a grand way by IPA.

Annual Report by Dr. N. Srinivas- Director SNVPMV

Dr. N. Srinivas, Director SNVPMV has addressed the gathering and presented annual report of SNVPMV by quoting that Sarojini Naidu Vanita Pharmacy Maha Vidyalaya was established in 1997-98 managed by The Exhibition Society, which conducts the All-India Industrial Exhibition (AIIE) every year, popularly known as "Numaish", the proceeds of which are utilized for managing 19 educational institutions including our college. Our institution is ISO 9000:2015 Certified & the B. Pharmacy Course is NBA Accredited till 2025. SNVPMV was inaugurated in Exhibition Grounds, Nampally on 9th September 1998 & relocated to Tarnaka in 2014, into the corporate-styled building, which was inaugurated by Sri K. Chandrasekhar Garu, Hon'ble Chief Minister, Telangana State. Decennial Celebrations were held on 16th March 2019, with Vice President of India Sri Venkaiah Naidu garu, as the Chief Guest.

The salient features of SNVPMV are –

- The institution offers B. Pharmacy with 100 Intake, Pharm. D course with 30 intake and three M. Pharmacy specializations - Pharmaceutics, Pharma Analysis & Pharma Quality Assurance. In the AY 2023-24, we are commencing Regulatory Affairs & Pharmacology in M. Pharmacy besides Pharm.D Post Baccalaureate program also.

- We maintain strict compliance with Rule & Regulations laid down by the statutory bodies like Osmania University & Pharmacy Council of India. In fact, we surpass the prescribed norms of infrastructure, faculty and equipment.
- SNVPMV provides 13 classrooms & 5 tutorial rooms, which are well-ventilated and provided with LCD projector & screen which are sufficient for conducting the classwork of all the existing courses, the new courses commencing this year and even if we add couple of new courses in next Academic Year, without having to move the students from one room to the other.
- We have 21 modern modular laboratories with attached preparation rooms having concealed piping for gas, water and drain lines, prioritizing the compliance with all the safety norms. We have 112 CC cameras at strategic locations across the entire campus. Our campus and hostel are Wi-Fi-enabled. We are providing 50 KW Solar Panels in the Academic Block. Power backup generator of 63 KV capacity.
- Our institution is known for the State-of-the-art equipment such as HPLC, FTIR, Flame Photometer, fluorimeter, Electrophoresis, UV-Visible Spectrophotometer, Rotary Tablet Machine, Tablet Coating Machine, various mills & Mixers, Stability Chambers, Probe Sonicator, Entire Range of Screening equipment – No exaggeration in stating that we have the capability for “New Product Development” which involves API Characterization, Formulation Development, *in vitro* & *in vivo* Evaluation. In compliance with CPCSEA norms, we have established state-of-art animal house and we are conducting for UG & PG research projects, with the approval from IAEC.
- Virtual Pharmacy was inaugurated on 12th July 2021, which is first of its kind in the Country as it familiarizes the students with all the logistics of drug store management.
- We have well-stacked library with 250 seating capacity, on the top floor with centralized Air-conditioning and has 1203 titles, 12732 volumes, 24 national and 16 international journals. Library Functions for extended times 9.30 to 7.30 p.m.
- We have an air-conditioned auditorium with a 250-seating capacity and a seminar hall with 150 seating capacity.
- College facilities are put to the best utilization for the students benefit by our Research-oriented faculty. We have 50 faculty out of which 17 are PhD-holders while another 17 faculty are pursuing their Doctoral Program. Our faculty published 21 national and 11

international research Articles. 10 faculty attended FDP's, 12 faculty attended various refresher courses, 44 faculty underwent QIP sessions, 6 Faculty participated in QIP programs as Resource Persons

- Dr. B. Shiva Jyothi received Patent in the method of preparing nitric oxide donating quinazoline fused Pyrazole derivatives as cytotoxic agents on 26th April, 2022. Dr C. Krishnaveni & Dr. M. Swetha were awarded with Ph.D, recently. Dr. Venu received Best Pharmacy Teacher Award by PCI – Telangana State Pharmacy Council on 5th Sep 2022 Dr. Sirisha presented concept note on granted patent at PCI organized Pharma Anveshan-2023 at Vigyan Bhavan, New Delhi, on 6th April, 2023.
- 150 Students have participated in RIMPS INTERNATIONAL Conference & presented their research abstracts. 26 students have presented scientific papers at 72 IPC, 2023 held at Nagapur. 110 students have participated in 3day International conference BIOME, 2023 at Kanha Shanthi Vanam. 210 students have visited to KIMS Hospital as a part of Knowledge tour. 38 students presented Oral & Poster presentation of Techno Pharm 2023 conducted for O.U.
- We provide conducive working atmosphere for faculty along with regular increments, PF & Gratuity benefits as per the rules of the State Government.

Academic Performance during 2021-2022

B.Pharmacy overall pass percentage: 95% with 33 Distinctions, 32 & First Class. while

Pharm D course overall pass percentage was 100% with 19 Distinctions & 4 students securing First Class. M.Pharm. overall pass percentage was 100% with 25 Distinctions & 1 student securing First Class.

Address by Dr. T.V. Narayana - Chief Guest

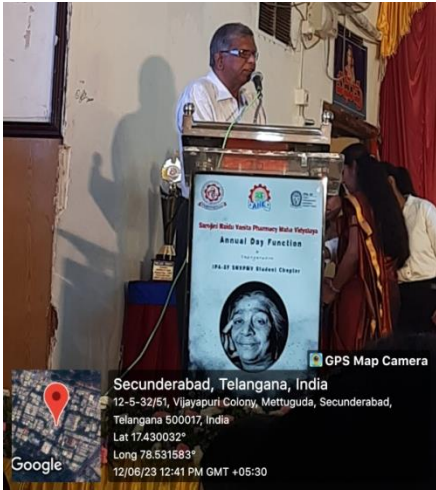
