Sarojini Naidu Vanita Pharmacy Maha Vidyalaya (SNVPMV) has a strong commitment to PBL. PBL is integrated into the curriculum of all pharmacy programs at SNVPMV, including the B. Pharm, M. Pharm, and Pharm. D programs.

PBL projects at SNVPMV are designed to be challenging and relevant to the pharmacy profession. Students work in teams to research and solve problems, and they are encouraged to be creative and innovative in their solutions.

Here are some examples of PBL projects that pharmacy students at SNVPMV have worked on in different specializations:

#### Pharmaceutics:

- Develop a new formulation for a medication that is easier to administer or more effective.
- Study the stability of a medication and develop a plan to improve its stability.
- Evaluate the bioequivalence of two different formulations of a medication.

#### Pharmacology:

- Investigate the mechanism of action of a new drug and its potential side effects.
- Develop a new drug therapy for a disease or condition.
- Conduct a clinical trial to evaluate the safety and efficacy of a new drug.

#### Pharmaceutical Analysis:

- Develop a new analytical method to detect and quantify a drug or its metabolites.
- Validate an existing analytical method for a drug or its metabolites.
- Apply an analytical method to a real-world sample to determine the presence or concentration of a drug or its metabolites.

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- Conduct a research study to evaluate the effectiveness of a medication or drug therapy.

### Pharmacognosy

- Identify and isolate active compounds from medicinal plants.
- Study the pharmacological activity of medicinal plant extracts.
- Develop new herbal formulations for the treatment of diseases.
- Evaluate the safety and efficacy of herbal formulations.
- Conduct clinical trials of herbal formulations.

### Pharmaceutical Chemistry

- Synthesize a new molecule ,improving its yield
- A new derivative, imparting a pharmacological action
