

#### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into on this date 2<sup>nd</sup> June, 2022

#### BETWEEN

Sarojini Naidu Vanita Pharmacy Maha Vidyalaya, 12-5-31/32, Vijayapuri Colony, Tarnaka, Secunderabad – 500017, Telangana, the First Party represented herein by its representative Dr. B.Prabha Shankar, Chairman, (hereinafter referred as 'First Party', the institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators and assigns).

#### AND

Jie Du Center for Innovation and Excellence for Drug Development, University of the Pacific, 3601 Pacific Ave, Stockton, CA 95211, United States of America (USA), the Second Party, and represented herein by Bhaskara Jasti, Executive Director, (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party", the institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators and assigns).

#### WHEREAS:

A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named: Sarojini Naidu Vanita Pharmacy Maha Vidyalaya, Secunderabad, is a premier institution in the field of pharmacy, affiliated to Osmania University, Hyderabad. It is sponsored and managed by The Exhibition Society, Hyderabad. An institution of excellence for pharmaceutical education, it endeavors to provide a leading knowledge and networking platform for young women aspirants to make change as accountable healthcare professionalspharmacists, pharmaceutical scientists, who are engaged in health promotion, disease prevention, assessment, monitoring, initiation and modification of usage of medication to assure safe and effective drug therapy regimens.

- B) Jie Du Center for Innovation and Excellence for Drug Development, University of the Pacific specializes in promoting innovation in drug development through education, training and mentorship, while fostering collaboration with industrial leaders. The institute offers the programs wherein, the students and scientists will gain skills in pharmaceutical regulation, entrepreneurship and business to prepare them for navigating the challenges associated with new ventures in drug development
- C) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- D) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of skill-based training, education, research, International faculty & student exchange programs, without involving any financial implications on either side.
- E) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.

# NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU), THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

#### **CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION**

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of definitive documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties.

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## CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MOU

- 2.1 This MoU facilitates a collaborative working relationship between both the institutes in the matters of research projects, student internships, conduct of seminars, conferences & symposia in the fields of drug development.
- 2.2 This will involve exchange of students and faculty for the purpose of advanced education, pharmaceutical research and outreach. Students will be exposed to different perspectives; traditions and it is a chance to step out of the comfort zone and gain experience through unfamiliar situations
- 2.3 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein
- 2.4 There is no financial commitment on the part of either parties to take up any program mentioned in the MOU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

### **CLAUSE 3: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY**

3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

#### CLAUSE 4: EFFECTIVE DATE & VALIDITY

- 4.1 This Agreement shall be effective from the date of its approval by competent authorities at both ends
- 4.2 This Agreement shall be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms.
- 4.3 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties will discharge their obligations.

#### **CLAUSE 5: AMENDMENTS**

5.1 Any amendment and/or addenda to any clause of this Agreement shall be in writing and signed by the PARTIES hereto and shall only after such execution be

deemed to form part of the AGREEMENT and have the effect of modifying the AGREEMENT to the extent required by such amendment or addenda.

## CLAUSE 6 : RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES

6.1 This agreement shall take effect and be construed in accordance with the Laws of India and be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts at Hyderabad.

# **REPORT ON GUEST LECTURE**

# Topic of the Event – Emerging Research Areas For R & D Projects in USA Date & Time of Event – 10<sup>th</sup> June 2022, 11:00 am

Sarojini Naidu Vanita Pharmacy Maha Vidyalaya (Sponsored by The Exhibition Society) organized a guest lecture on the topic "**Emerging Research Areas for R & D Projects in USA**" on 10<sup>th</sup> June 2022, at 11:00 AM. The Guest Speaker for the guest lecture was **Dr.Bhaskara Jasti**, Professor, Associate Dean of Graduate Education and Research Executive Director, Jie Du Centre for Innovation and Excellence for Drug Development, University of the Pacific, California, USA. 


He also informed the students about various graduate programme specializations offered by pharmacy colleges in the USA.
