MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU)

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is entered into on this date April, 2022

BETWEEN

Sainath Dayaker Shastri, Secretary cum Correspondent, (hereinafter referred as 'First Party', the institution which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators and assigns).

AND

Leesha Pharmatech Private Limited, #3-5-1094/14/1, Kamalamma Nilayam, Venkateshwara colony, Narayanaguda, Hyderabad - 500029, Telangana, the Second Party, and represented herein by Dr. B. Samay Chakravarthy, Managing Partner (hereinafter referred to as "Second Party", company which expression, unless excluded by or repugnant to the subject or context shall include its successors – in-office, administrators and assigns).



WHEREAS:

- Pharmacy Maha Vidyalaya, Secunderabad, is a premier institution in the field of pharmacy and its related courses, affiliated to Osmania University, Hyderabad. It is sponsored and managed by The Exhibition Society, Hyderabad. An institution of excellence for pharmaceutical education, it endeavors to provide a leading knowledge and networking platform for young women aspirants to make change as accountable healthcare professionals-pharmacists, pharmaceutical scientists, who are engaged in health promotion, disease prevention, assessment, monitoring, initiation and modification of usage of medication to assure safe and effective drug therapy regimens.
- B) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhance opportunities.
- C) The Parties intent to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Education and Research.
- D) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.
- E) Leesha Pharmatech Private Limited, Hyderabad, the Second Party is engaged in Business with phenomenal technical expertise in pharmaceutical API and formulation manufacturing, quality control, research and development.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU), THE PARTIES HERETO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION

1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization

- of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching / training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party.
- 1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties.

CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MOU

- 2.1 The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry.

 Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 2.2 Curriculum Design: Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching / training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.
- Industrial Training & Visits: Industry and Institution interaction will give an insight into the latest developments / requirements of the industries; the Second Party to permit the selected faculty and students of the First Party to visit its group companies and also involve in Industrial Training Programs for the First Party. The industrial training and exposure provided to meritorious students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career. The Second Party will provide its Labs / Workshops / Industrial Sites for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the First Party.
- 2.4 Internships and Placement of Students: Second Party will actively engage to help the delivery of the Internship and placement of meritorious students of the First Party into internships/jobs, as per the internship Policy.

2.5 Research and Development: Both Parties have agreed to carry out the joint

- research activities in the fields of Clinical Research developments.
- 2.6 Skill Development Programs: Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.
- 2.7 Guest Lectures: Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in house requirements.
- 2.8 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programs on the terms specified herein
- 2.9 There is no financial commitment on the part of the First Party to take up any program mentioned in the MOU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

CLAUSE 3: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

CLAUSE 4: EFFECTIVE DATE & VALIDITY

- 4.1 This Agreement shall be effective from the date of its approval by competent authorities at both ends
- 4.2 This Agreement shall be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms.
- 4.3 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

CLAUSE 5: AMENDMENTS

5.1 Any amendment and/or addenda to any clause of this Agreement shall be in writing and signed by the PARTIES hereto and shall only after such execution be deemed to form part of the AGREEMENT and have the effect of modifying the AGREEMENT to the extent required by such amendment or addenda.



CLAUSE 6: RESOLUTION OF DISPUTES

6.1 This agreement shall take effect and be construed in accordance with the Laws of India and be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts at Hyderabad.
