The Governing body of Sarojini Naidu Vanita Pharmacy Maha Vidyalaya inaugurated Free Health Check-up stall on 7<sup>th</sup> January 2022 by the Chief Guest Prof.C.K. Kokate at the 81<sup>st</sup> All India Exhibition. This health camp was organized at Nampally exhibition grounds from 07-01-2022 to 07-02-2022 for all the Public visiting Exhibition from various works of life. It was conducted mainly to spread awareness about health-check ups and maintenance of a healthy life. The program started at 6 p.m. with the introductory speech given by our Chairman, Dr.B.Prabha Shankar and involvement of Director Dr.N.Srinivas, Principal Dr.T.Saritha Jyostna and Dr.T.Venu, HOD of Pharmacology and Pharm.D.

The teaching and non-teaching staff, student volunteers involved actively in this post marketing surveillance study and performed the services to serve the public and check the health status of each individual.

Our services :

1. To monitor B.P. (Using Digital BP apparatus )
2. To make a line and get individual height and weight checked to calculate BMI (Body mass index) to identify whether the person is healthy or not.
3. Diabetes test (To check the blood glucose levels)
4. Lipid profile test (To check the cholesterol levels)
5. Counselling the patients regarding diet and health issues using counselling aids.

The duration of the study was for 4 weeks from 7<sup>th</sup> January - 7<sup>th</sup> February 2022 every day from 11:00 a.m - 6:00 p.m. Each faculty with one student have checked several people overall for BMI, blood report and other health conditions if any upto 4 weeks.
