

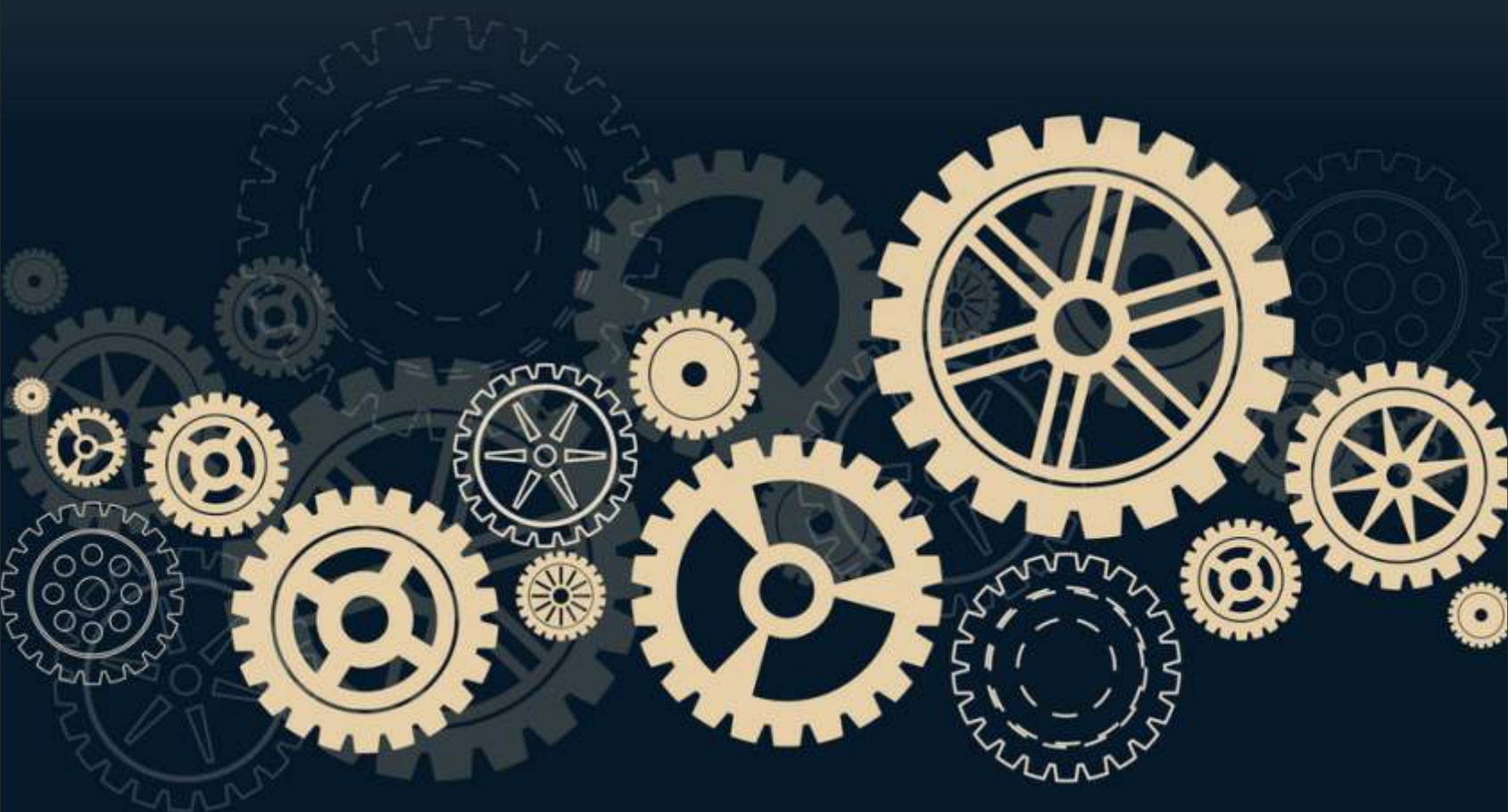

# ABOUT OUR SPONSORS & INSTITUTION





## EXHIBITION SOCIETY

The Exhibition Society is a non-profit organization registered under the Companies Act 1956. It was started in 1938 to promote industrial development in the erstwhile Hyderabad State in Nizam Era by organizing industrial exhibition with an Objective to promote products manufactured by small and medium scale industries within the country and to promote social, economic and industrial environment in the State in particular and in the country in general.

Services rendered by the Members of the Exhibition Society are all honorary and they are from various walks of life.

The 1st Exhibition was conducted at Public Gardens in 1938. The venue of Exhibition was shifted to the present Exhibition Grounds in 1946. Since then, the Exhibition is held from 1st January to 15th February every year. All India Industrial Exhibition is a heritage event closely woven into the ethos and history of Hyderabad State. The citizens of Hyderabad anxiously and eagerly wait for the Exhibition every year.

The Exhibition Society celebrated its Silver Jubilee in 1965, Golden Jubilee in 1998, Diamond Jubilee in 2000 and Platinum Jubilee in 2015. The Exhibition Society had the honor of the visits to our exhibitions by many luminaries like Dr. C. Rajagopala Chary, Dr. Rajendra Prasad, Dr.S.Radha Krishnan, Frontier Gandhi Khan Abdul Gaffar Khan, Sardar Gyani Zail Singh, Dr.V.V.Giri, Dr.Shankar Dayal Sharma, Dr.Zakir Hussain, Dr.Fakruddin Ali Ahmed, Dr.N.Sanjeev Reddy, Lal Bahadur Shastri, Gulzarilal Nanda, Morarji Desai and many Central Ministers. It is a tradition to inaugurate the All India Industrial Exhibition every year by the Chief Minister of the State.

Stallholders from Kashmir, Uttar Pradesh, West Bengal, Rajasthan, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Haryana, Punjab, Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Karnataka, the State & Central Government Departments, Public Sector Undertakings, multinational companies have been participating in the Exhibition for the past 8 decades. Around 2500 Stalls are allotted every year. About 1,000 small & medium entrepreneurs are given an opportunity to market their products and earn income to sustain for rest of the year. Exhibition Society have been generating significant income for the Government since its inception. We provided direct and in-direct employment to about 10,000 persons every year.

The Exhibition Society has a unique fire safety equipment in the entire grounds with 100 fire hydrants and underground water pipeline system to put off the fire in minutes. Each fire hydrant is equivalent to 1 fire engine.

The proceeds generated from the AIIIE (Numaish) are utilised for sponsoring and managing 20 Educational Institutions located in the backward areas of Hyderabad and other districts of Telangana, providing good infrastructure, imparting quality education to about 30,000 students at an affordable fee. Our Institution offers KG to PG courses including Engineering and Pharmacy. About 2,000 teaching & non-teaching staff are employed in the 20 educational institutions funded and managed by Exhibition Society and Osmania Graduates Association. Most of our Institutions are prestigious and are NAAC accredited and have celebrated Golden Jubilee / Silver Jubilee. The Sarojini Naidu Pharmacy Maha Vidyalaya which was started in 1998 has grown up to a prestigious institution.

## ECONOMIC COMMITTEE ANDHRA PRADESH

Establishment of Economic Committee was a milestone in the History of not only Osmania Graduates Association but also in the History of Exhibition Society.

In the early thirties graduates carried tremendous dignity, social status and responsibility. They were treated as enlightened elite. This motivated them to widen their perception and explore the possibilities to work in social, economic and political fields. They have realized that it was important to address the problems relating to the economic backwardness of the state and felt the need to set up suitable wings separately to address these issues. After prolonged sessions of deliberations and discussions, the elders of Osmania Graduates Association have initiated many sub committees to cover all aspects of development. In the year 1938 one of the such committees established was Economic Sub-Committee.

Gradually, The Economic Sub Committee has gained promptness due to the reason that this committee was interested with major responsibilities such as ;

- Conducting a comprehensive survey to assess socio-economic conditions of the people.
- To recommend to the government to provide suitable employment opportunities.
- To take up positive measures towards the industrialization of the state to place the economic growth on sound and firm footing.
- To guide and encourage the Osmania Graduates to start small scale industries so that they can enhance their economic status in the society.

Economic Committee envisaged providing an appropriate platform to market products of newly established industrial houses while encouraging them to enter into industrial activities.

This humble attempt of Economic Committee resulted in birth of Exhibition Society in the year 1938 and got registered as “Exhibition Society Economic Committee” on 29-11-1349 vide statement No. III SL No.1 under new companies Limited by guarantee and Associations not for profit registered during the year 1349 Fasli.

The first Industrial exhibition known as “Numaish Mansunathe Mulki” with 100 stalls was organized in the year 1938 at Public Garden at Hyderabad which was considered as highly successful. Subsequently an independent body known as “Exhibition Society” was registered under “Companies Act”.

The first Industrial Exhibition started by Economic Committee has now come to be known as “All India Industrial Exhibition (AIIE)” considered being the biggest show window for Trade, Industry and Commerce in the country attracting participants from all over the country. Thus the early promoters of the Economic Committee are responsible for today's prominent role and contribution of AIIE, in the fields of education and Industrial development of the state.

In the year 1958 our elders again registered our Organization as “The Economic Committee Andhra Pradesh” on 13-08-1958 under the Andhra Pradesh Societies Registration Act, 1350 Fasli (Act 1 of 1350 F).

During the initial stage in the 1980's, the Economic Committee has done well to fulfill its objectives, many seminars, workshops were conducted to encourage the industrial promoters. Many eminent persons have participated in the activities of Economic Committee and encouraged their ideas, experiences and expertise in the respective fields of Knowledge.

In the year 1990 on 17-10-1990 our General Body approved the Constitution once again with following as our Aims and Objectives.



1. To promote economic, social, industrial, educational and other allied activities.
2. To do all such other things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects and all round development of the country in general and state in particular.
3. To guide, advice and assist the Exhibition Society in the realization of its aims and objectives.

The Past Presidents, Secretaries, other office Bearers and Members and Members of the Managing Committee, worked diligently by promoting the Aims and Objectives of our Organization and made it one of the premier Organization and carried the Legacy, by conducting regularly Big Seminars, Workshops, Guest Lectures, Entrepreneurship Development Programs etc.

The Silver Jubilee celebrations of Economic Committee were organized in the year 1968-1969. After Silver Jubilee no other periodic celebrations like Golden Jubilee or Diamond Jubilee were organized.

Another mild stone in the history of Economic Committee, was established Sri. Bhramarambika Mallikarjuna Swamy College of Education at Kalvakurthy, Mahaboob nagar District in Association with Osmania Graduates Association and Exhibition Society.

The Platinum Jubilee Inaugural Function was held on 18th Oct 2013. Dr. C. Rangarajan Chairman, Economic Advisory Council to the Prime Minister, Government of India, was the Chief Guest.

Today the Economic and Industrial scenario is drastically changing under the influence of Globalization etc. there by enhancing our responsibility towards the Society. Many New Challenges will be emergy in the field of Economic Development and we as Members of Economic Committee can try to rededicate ourselves to address the Newly Emerging Challenges. This is possible with the cooperation and active participation of all the Members of Economic Committee.

We are reiterating once again that our immediate priorities are:

- To Organize and conduct seminars, Workshops and Symposia on current issues of National/ International interests on a regular basis.
- To create equal opportunities for interested members to serve in planning organizing the above events.

We appreciate and respect your active participation, support in accomplishing all our future Programs.

## OSMANIA GRADUATES ASSOCIATION

Osmania University was established in 1919. Osmania Graduates' Association (OGA) was born on 25th November, 1932. Thirteenth year after OU was established. The only organization of its kind which has the distinction of being an Alumni philanthropic body, providing services in the field of education, economic and social welfare of the community since 9 decades and continuing its services in the field of higher education.

Graduate in early thirties i.e., prior to Independence carried tremendous dignity social status and responsibilities. They were treated as enlightened elite. This has naturally motivated them to widen their perception and explore the possibilities to work in social economic and political fields. This is how Osmania Graduates' Association came into existence to promote overall development of erstwhile Hyderabad State. Prominent among them were Sri Shankar Ji, Mir Akbar Ali Khan, Mir Ahmed Ali Khan and others.

To expand the activities of OGA, Education Committee was formed. Subsequently in 1938 OGA decided to form a committee namely "Economic Committee Exhibition Society" to create a platform to the artisans and small-scale industrialists of the State to exhibit their skills and get market for their products. To achieve this goal, the Economic Committee initiated the idea of holding Industrial Exhibition in Hyderabad. The Exhibition became instantly popular drawing huge crowds and appreciation of the visitors and the elite of the city. The growing popularity of the annual All India Industrial Exhibition yielded surplus revenues which the OGA wisely decided to utilize for educational activities more particularly women's education.

In 1957-58 the OGA decided to register Economic Committee and Exhibition Society separately accordingly "Exhibition Society" was registered under companies act and "Economic Committee AP" was registered under societies act. OGA has interwoven all the three organizations for future coordination by making a provision in respective constitution to have the representation of Members of Economic Committee in Exhibition Society, vice versa. Similarly, there will be representation of OGA members in the managing committee of Economic Committee.

After 1960 the activities of OGA were radically changed under the leadership of a great man of vision and foresight Sri Shankar Ji. His emphasis on education in general and for women in particular led to the establishment of many Educational Institutions. The sister organization Exhibition Society became main funding source to all Educational Institutions sponsored by OGA and Exhibition Society.

1960 has a great significance in the annals of OGA and they could start a degree college for women in Hyderabad. This was turning point in the progressive history of OGA with a long term of objective to enter in the field of higher education. Thus, came into existence Vanita Mahavidyalaya in 1960 in the premises of Exhibition Grounds, which was subsequently named as "Sarojini Naidu Maha Vidyalaya". This college has a magnificent building and it is worthwhile to mention that foundation stone of this college building was laid by veteran freedom fighter Shri Khan Abdul Gaffar Khan popularly known as 'Frontier Gandhi'.

The next educational institution started in pursuit of the lofty aims of spreading higher education was Kamala Nehru Polytechnic for Women by the Exhibition Society in the year 1961. This institution attracted the attention of the entire country as it was the first polytechnic college for women. The foundation stone was laid by Shri Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru former Prime Minister of India and the college was inaugurated by Smt. Indira Gandhi former Prime Minister of India.

Thus year on year climbing high to realize the aim of spreading higher education, OGA and Exhibition Society together have established 20 Educational Institutions, which include High School, Intermediate, Degree and Post Graduate Colleges, Polytechnics, ITIs and Pharmacy and Engineering Colleges. The total number of students in these institutions is around 30,000 and nearly 2,000 staff are working in these institutions.

The Silver Jubilee celebrations of Osmania Graduates' Association were organized in 1957. Dr.B.Gopal Reddy, Minister for Finance, Govt. of Andhra Pradesh inaugurated and the event was attended by many eminent personalities.

The 27th Annual Conference of Osmania Graduates Association was inaugurated on 21st August 1959 by the President of India Dr. Rajendra Prasad.

The OGA celebrated its Golden Jubilee function on a grand scale in 1983 to commemorate its five decades of services. The event was inaugurated by Dr. Giani Zail Singh, Hon'ble President of India and participated by many dignitaries like Sri P.Shiv Shanker, Hon'ble Union Minister for Energy, Govt of India, Sri C. Jagannath Rao, Deputy Chief Minister of A.P. Dr.Balram Jakkur, Hon'ble Speaker of Lok Sabha, was the chief guest for valedictory function.



The Diamond jubilee was organized in a befitting manner in 1998. The event was inaugurated by Sri G.M.C Balayogi, Hon'ble Speaker of Lok Sabha and participated by Sri A. Madhava Reddy, Hon'ble Minister for Home, Govt. of A.P.

The Platinum Jubilee Celebrations were inaugurated on 31st August 2008 by Sri S. Jaipal Reddy, Hon'ble Minister for Urban Development, Govt. of India in presence of Sri K. Jana Reddy, Hon'ble Home Minister, Govt. of A.P.

The Osmania Graduates' Association in coordination with the Exhibition Society and Economic Committee AP has felicitated the newly appointed Vice-Chancellors of Telangana State on 6.11.2021 in the Lawns, behind the Golden Jubilee Block.

Prof. R. Limbadri, Chairman, Telangana State Council of Higher Education was invited as the chief Guest.

6. To progress towards an egalitarian society through the emancipation of women with the acquisition of knowledge and empowerment

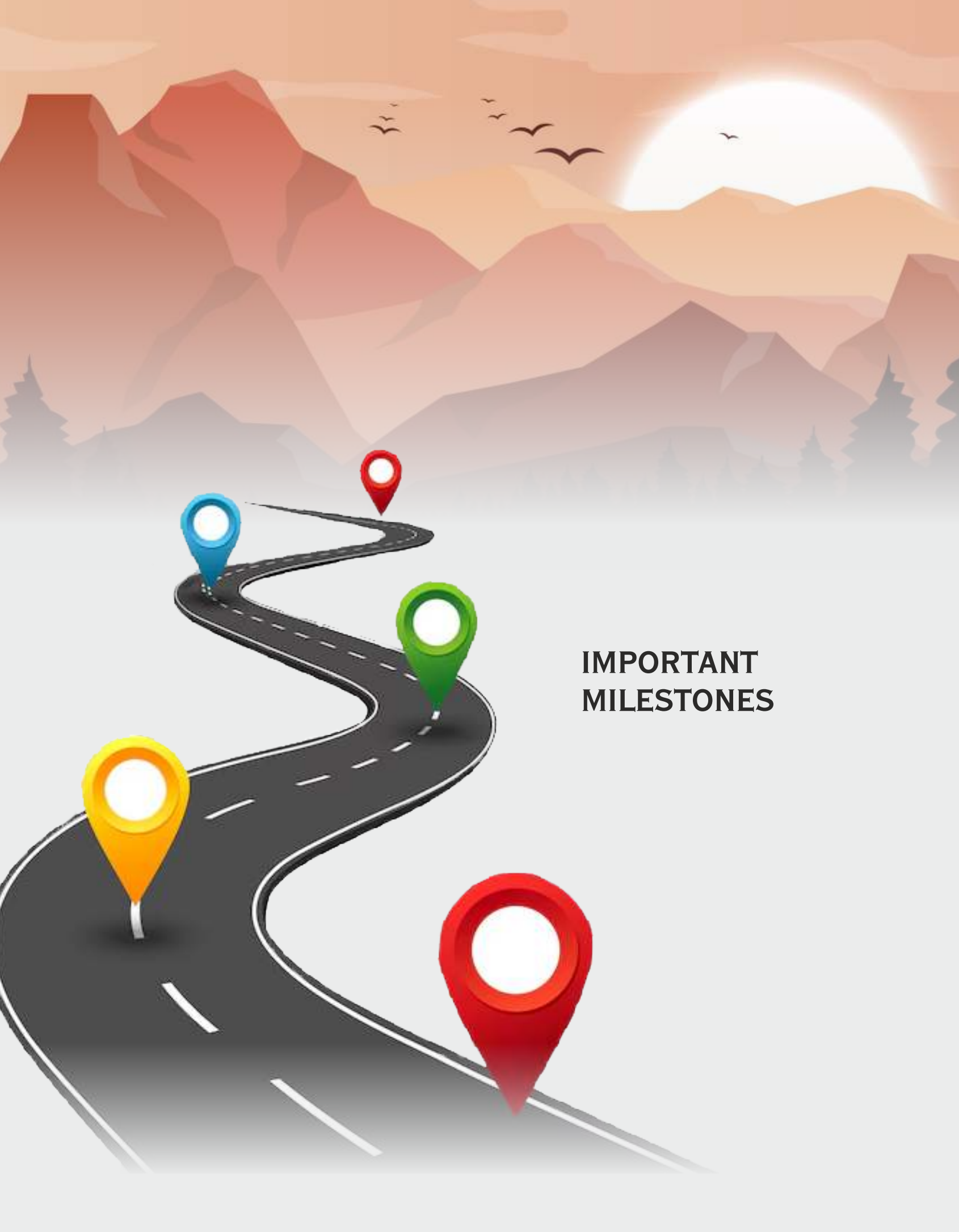

## VIRTUAL PHARMACY



Virtual Pharmacy was inaugurated by Sri Navin Mittal, IAS, Commissioner of Technical Education, Govt. of Telangana and Prof. C. K. Kokate, former Vice Chancellor K.L.E. Deemed University, former Vice Chancellor Kakatiya University, and former President, Pharmacy Council of India, in Sarojini Naidu Vanita Pharmacy Maha Vidyalaya. This virtual Pharmacy contains the outer cartons of all medicines, cosmetics and nutraceuticals exactly similar to medical shop, but without the medicines inside cartons. Virtual pharmacy enables an offsite pharmacy student to provide real time order verification and consultation, and gives hands-on experience to the students.

Virtual pharmacy familiarizes the students with logistics of pharmacy store management, role of pharmacist, and patients counseling. The infrastructure and initiatives like virtual pharmacy, plays a key role in imparting technical education. It is first of its kind in India and improves the employability of graduating students. It is the State-of-art facilities in SNVPMV created for the purpose of improving practical exposure to the students which familiarizes the students with all the logistics of drug store management. It is created in the ground floor near to the entrance, and accessible to all the students



- Virtual pharmacy provides real-time order verification, patient counselling in various therapeutic segments and check the drug – drug interactions of the prescriptions

- Students learn to perform the role of Pharmacist, vital sign measurements, monitoring and auditing of drug store activities

- Virtual pharmacy provides a unique opportunity to know therapeutic segment-wise brand names of drug products and their manufacturers apart from understanding the inventory management principles.

- We have placed 2700 products of various brands which belong to different pharmacological classes that are listed in computer with 10 columns under different headings like generic name, indications, storage conditions etc.

- All the students of college will visit the virtual pharmacy once in week as per the time table and become familiar to the drugs and their brands names etc.

- It also contains 60% of drug & surgical products, and remaining 40 % comprises nutraceuticals, cosmetics products

- Virtual pharmacy a unique facility of SNVPMV which is like a drug library to the students and giving real time experience like a pharmacy

Dr. Mansoor A. Khan delivered an insightful lecture on academia's role in setting standards for complex generics. He emphasized the importance of mastering critical subjects and shared the challenges in approving generics and providing biowaivers.

Topic: Regulatory Affairs – FDA Drug Product Approvals

Dr. Mansoor A. Khan elaborately explained the FDA's mission to ensure drug safety and efficacy, detailing the distinctions between laws, regulations, and guidance. Dr. Khan covered the drug approval process, from preclinical studies to post-marketing surveillance, emphasizing the need for substantial evidence. He highlighted the importance of FDA meetings and compliance with Good Manufacturing Practices (cGMPs).

Scientific poster and oral presentations were conducted department-wise manner with pre-assigned codes. The total number of oral presentations were 23 and poster presentations were 224. The evaluators were invited from the academia and Industry who have adjudged the poster and oral presentations.

## SESSION-4

Speaker: **Dr. Rajender R. Aparasu**, Ph.D., FAPhA, Mustafa and Sanobar Lokhandwala Endowed Professor, Department Chair & P-HOPER Center Director

Topic: Safety Profile of Antimuscarinics in Older Adults with Dementia

Chairperson: Dr. K. Satyanarayana, Former VP: R&D, NATCO Pharma Ltd, Hyderabad

Co-chairperson: Dr. Lingaiah Nagarapu, Chief Scientist & Professor, CSIR, IICT, Hyderabad

The session explored the safety of non-selective versus selective antimuscarinics in older adults with dementia and overactive bladder (OAB). Funded by the National Institute on Aging (NIA), the study used Medicare claims data to assess risks such as falls, fractures, and mortality. He discussed the results of study and emphasized the financial advantage and convenience in the conduct of observational epidemiological studies in the pharmaceutical research. He also explained and clarified the queries on the Ph.D. admissions at the University of Houston. He also emphasized the procedures of research and teaching assistantships in the University.

## SESSION-5

Speaker: **Dr. Indra K. Reddy**, Interim Chief Operating Officer and Senior Vice-President, A&M University Health Science Center, Bryan, Texas, US.

Topic: "Rx for Success - Motivating Pharmacy Students to Aim Higher"

Chairperson: Mr K Subbi Reddy, Former Joint Director, A.P. Drug Control Administration

Co-Chairperson: Dr.V.Venkateshwarlu, Managing Director, NEUHEIT Pharma Ltd

The speaker highlighted that 50% of Americans have at least one chronic condition, with seniors (16% of the population) accounting for 40% of healthcare costs. Medication non-adherence costs \$300 billion annually. Pharmacists, crucial in addressing the challenges, play vital roles in various settings, administering 70% of vaccinations and ensuring medication safety. He explained the evolving role of pharmacists in personalized medicine, 3D printing, and managing the opioid crisis. Emphasizing professional identity formation and interprofessional education, the session underscored pharmacists' expanding role in healthcare. Dr. A. V. Srikanth, Vice Chairman SNVPMV requested Dr. Indra K Reddy to consider conducting an orientation program for achieving academic leadership in running the institutions sponsored by the Exhibition Society, for which the Speaker has consented to discuss modalities for conducting an orientation program (online / offline mode) at the earliest.

## SESSION 6

Speaker: **Mr. Sudhakar Paul**, President & CEO, PTS Labs, Lenexa, KS USA.

Topic: "Research & Development to Prescription (R&D to Rx)-Business Perspective".

Chairperson: Mr. L. Prasad, Educationalist.

Co-Chairperson: Dr. Uma Vasireddy, EC Member, IPA Telangana State Branch.

Mr. Sudhakar detailed the complex process and financial considerations in generic drug development, emphasizing market exclusivity periods, development stages, and regulatory frameworks. He noted that pharmaceutical R&D investment averages 19% of revenues, higher than other research-intensive industries. U.S. pharmaceutical sales reached \$700 billion in 2023, projected to exceed \$1 trillion by 2030. The 15-stage development process includes reverse engineering, bioequivalence testing, and FDA submissions, emphasizing regulatory knowledge. The seminar highlighted promising career opportunities in pharmacovigilance, global clinical research, and regulatory fields for pharmacy graduates. The event concluded with Mr. Sudhakar signing an MoU with SNVPMV.

## SESSION 7

Speaker: **Ms. Suman Shanker**, Retd. Senior Scientist, Pfizer Worldwide R&D

Topic: "Discovery of New Medicines Enabled by Structural Biology: Case Studies"

Chairperson: Prof. V. Kishan, Former Professor, Department of Pharmaceutical Biotechnology, UCPSc, Kakatiya University, Warangal

Co-Chairperson Dr. R. Ashok Kumar, Technical Advisor-Sarabhai Group, R & D Advisor-SNVPMV

Suman Shanker's presentation detailed the complex drug discovery process, emphasizing the crucial role of structural biology in developing new medicines. Highlighting the lengthy, costly nature of drug discovery, Ms. Shanker explained how structural biology elucidates three-dimensional structures of biological molecules, enabling precise drug design. Technological advancements like genomics and molecular modeling have been shown to accelerate drug development. Case studies, including Pfizer's Paxlovid® for COVID-19 and a UTI vaccine, illustrated these concepts. Shanker concluded by stressing interdisciplinary collaboration and continuous innovation. She has offered to guide the students of SNVPMV on research-related activities.

## SESSION 8

The scientific oral and poster presentations were organized in continuation of the first day's events with a panel of 40 adjudicators from various specializations. These experts thoroughly evaluated the presentations, declaring the results and awarding prizes to the winners. The adjudicators were felicitated for their contributions by the dignitaries from SNVPMV.

Following the scientific sessions, cultural events were organized in the Tagore Auditorium, O.U. Campus. The activities included group dance performances showcasing a variety of themes such as Indian folk, Indo-western fusion, Bhangra, Garba & Dandiya, Navaratri festival dances, classical dances, and skits showcasing women's empowerment.

Speaker: **Prof. U. Vindhya**, Former Professor of Psychology & Deputy Director, Tata Institute of Social Sciences, Hyderabad

Topic: "Work-Family Balance: Is it an issue for Women only?"

Co-chairperson: Ms. Sanghimitra Dalal, Head New Product Launches, Dr. Reddy's Laboratories

Prof. U. Vindhya expressed concern that despite increasing female enrollment in Indian higher education, achieving gender parity in employment remains challenging. While 42% of STEM students are women, India ranks 140th in the 2021 Global Gender Gap Report, with only 27% female workforce participation. She felt that the socio-cultural norms, marriage, motherhood, and caregiving roles hinder women's employment. She further stated that the educational gains often don't translate to workforce participation due to societal pressures and women also face differential access to resources and endure violence. Prof. U. Vindhya felt that the true gender equality involves empowering all individuals to reach their potential, transcending traditional norms.

Topic: "You are a Product - How Value Addition Will Help Stand Out from the Crowd"

Co-chairperson: Prof. B. Sunitha Reddy, Professor & Principal, UCPSc, JNTUH, Sultanpur

Sri J.P. Naidu's seminar emphasized students viewing themselves as competitive products, stressing value addition to enhance employability in a saturated job market. Highlighting the skill gap in pharmacy education, he urged students to prioritize soft skills alongside academic achievements. Mrs. Anupama Naidu's session focused on mental and physical wellness, addressing prevalent issues like stress and anxiety among students. She advocated for self-care practices including meditation and yoga to improve overall well-being. The sessions collectively underscored the importance of continuous self-improvement for success in academia and professional life. Both seminars concluded with felicitation by the dignitaries of SNVPMV, acknowledging their contributions to student development.

Sri Shekar Mandrekar highlighted personalized medicine's potential in tailoring treatments through genomic data integration, improving patient outcomes while addressing ethical considerations. He emphasized patient-centric drug development, regulatory alignment, and environmental sustainability. Overcoming adoption challenges requires integrating digital solutions and robust regulatory frameworks. Breakthrough innovations in genomics and data analytics drive precision medicine, empowering patients and enhancing treatment effectiveness. Despite drug development complexities, data-driven decision-making and strategic partnerships facilitate innovation and market access. Sri Mandrekar urged the pharmaceutical industry to embrace digital health and collaboration for improved patient care and a healthier future.

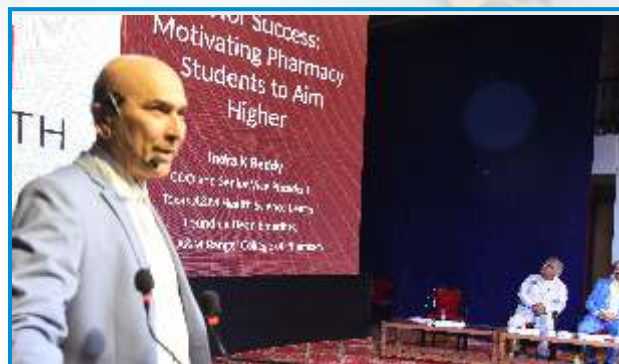

As a matter of respect, the college was named as Sarojini Naidu Vanitha Pharmacy Maha Vidyalaya.

The trio of Sri Ranga Rao garu, Sri Surenderji garu and Dr. Ganagadhar Rao garu have worked ceaselessly for acquiring new equipment, construction of new labs, library books and above all the teaching staff. Finances never came in the matter of sanctions. It is heartening to see some of the first era faculty even now. Actual classes for the first batch started on 17th January 1998 i.e. exactly one year after submitting the initial proposals.

I vividly remember in one of the inspections, the Director of Academic cell of Osmania University openly asked me how is it possible for one institution to achieve such high academic distinctions repeatedly.
