#### **Exhibition Society**

The Exhibition Society is a non-profit organization registered under the Companies Act 1956. It was started in the year 1938, by Osmania Graduates Association (OGA) to promote industrial development in the erstwhile Hyderabad State by organizing industrial exhibitions to promote products manufactured by small and medium scale industries within the country. This is perhaps the only instance in the world where the alumni of Osmania University have been responsible for establishing educational institutions for the needy and support them financially by conducting an industrial exhibition every year.

The Exhibition Society was formally registered in 1957-58 with the following objectives:

- · Promote social, economic and industrial environment in the state in particular and in the country in general.
- The Exhibition Society will be used as a medium to educate people and to project an image of self-reliance and self-help.
- The membership will be limited and members will not be paid any remuneration for the work rendered and that all the profits and savings will be utilized for development purposes.

The Exhibition Society conducts the All India Industrial Exhibition (AIIE) every year, popularly known as "Numaish".

The 1<sup>st</sup> AllE was conducted at Public Garden in 1938 and the venue was shifted to the present Exhibition Grounds in Nampally in 1946. The Exhibition Society celebrated its Silver Jubilee in 1965, Golden Jubilee in 1998, Diamond Jubilee in 2000 and Platinum Jubilee in 2015. The All India Industrial Exhibition is a heritage event closely woven into the ethos and history of Hyderabad and the citizens eagerly wait for it every year. Many State Govt. Departments, such as, Police, Fire & Disaster Management, Electricity, GHMC, R&B, RTC, Metro etc. participate and facilitate in the smooth conduct of the event.

#### **CENTRAL INSTRUMENTATION LABORATORY:**

The Central Instrumentation Lab is a cutting-edge facility equipped with advanced analytical instruments for pharmaceutical analysis, supporting research and development, quality control, and quality assurance activities in the campus. It plays a vital role in ensuring the safety, efficacy, and quality of pharmaceutical products, driving innovation and compliance with regulatory standards. The lab features a range of sophisticated instruments like HPLCs, UV Spectrophotometers, FTIR, Flame Photometer, Fluorimeter, Nepheloturbidimeter, Electrophoresis etc.





This facility serves all the departments of Pharmacy, including Pharmaceutical Chemistry, Pharmacology, Pharmaceutics, and Pharmacognosy, among others. Experienced scientists, faculty and technicians working in the lab, provide expert analytical services, method development, and validation.

#### **MODEL PHARMACY**

Model Pharmacy was inaugurated by Sri Navin Mittal, IAS, Commissioner of Technical Education, Govt. of Telangana and Prof. C. K. Kokate, former Vice Chancellor K.L.E. Deemed University, former Vice Chancellor Kakatiya University, and former President, Pharmacy Council of India, on 12th July, 2021.

The Model Pharmacy facility is first of its kind in the Country as it familiarizes the students with all the logistics of drug store management.

- Model pharmacy provides real-time order verification, patient counseling in various therapeutic segments and check the drug — drug interactions of the prescriptions
- Students learn to perform the role of Pharmacist, vital sign measurements, monitoring and auditing of drug store activities



 Model pharmacy provides a unique opportunity to know therapeutic segment-wise brand names of drug products and their manufacturers apart from understanding the inventory management principles.



#### LIBRARY

- A fully air conditioned well-stacked library on the top floor with ample ventilation convenient for effective study/reading.
- It is well spread out over a plinth area of 150 sq. mt.





#### **Mentoring**

Thus, mentoring significantly improves the knowledge, skills, perspective, insight, or wisdom among the students.


