# REPORT ON UBA VILLAGE VIST (PEDDATUPRA)

#### **Activities:**

On 28<sup>th</sup> September 2024 (Saturday), a group of 14 enthusiastic students and three faculty members Mr. D. Suresh, Mrs. A.Shailaja, Dr. M. Shiva Rama Krishna and two non faculty members Mr. Venkatesh and Mrs. Archana from Sarojini Naidu Vanita Pharmacy Maha Vidyalaya, Tarnaka, Secunderabad, Telangana embarked on a journey to Peddatoopra village as part of the Unnat Bharath Abhiyan initiative.

Upon arrival, the team was warmly welcomed by the head of the village, who extended his gratitude for choosing their village for the survey. Our team interacted with the villagers actively, we wasted no time and immediately got down to business along with some students of that village, who assisted the team.
