Topic: Clinical IND and NDA Submissions – Regulatory Dimensions

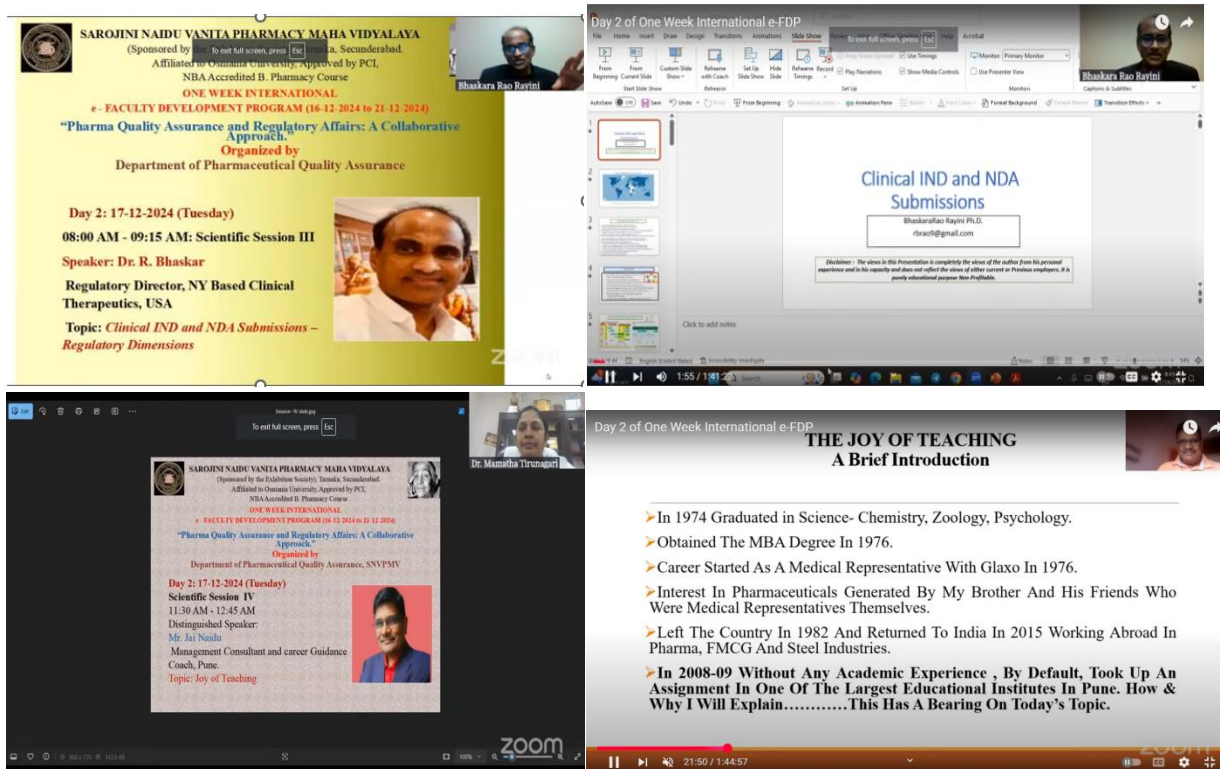

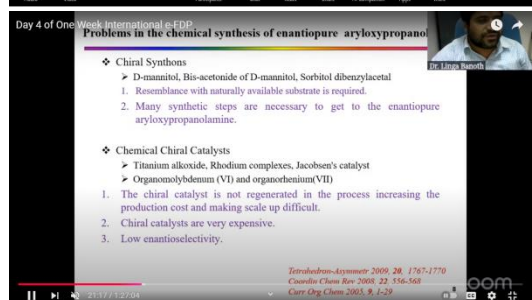
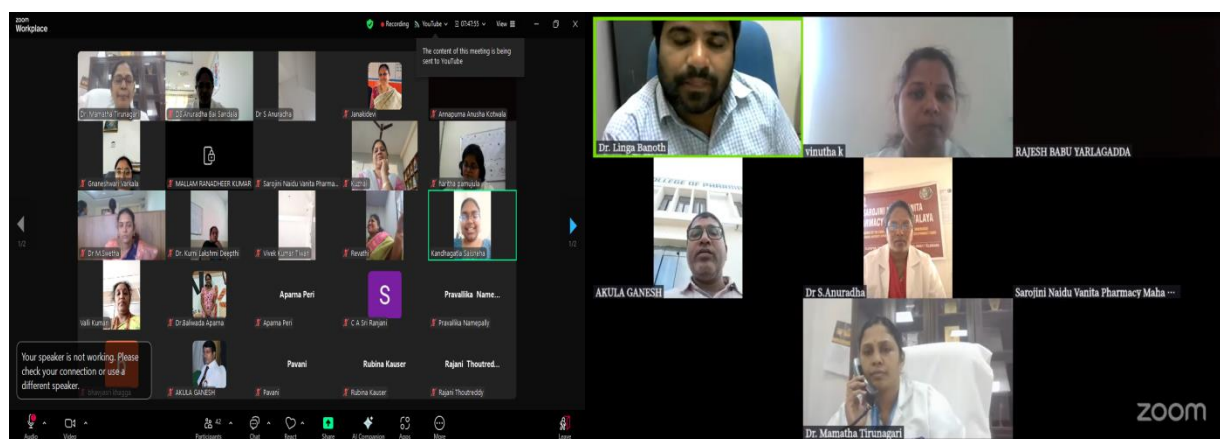
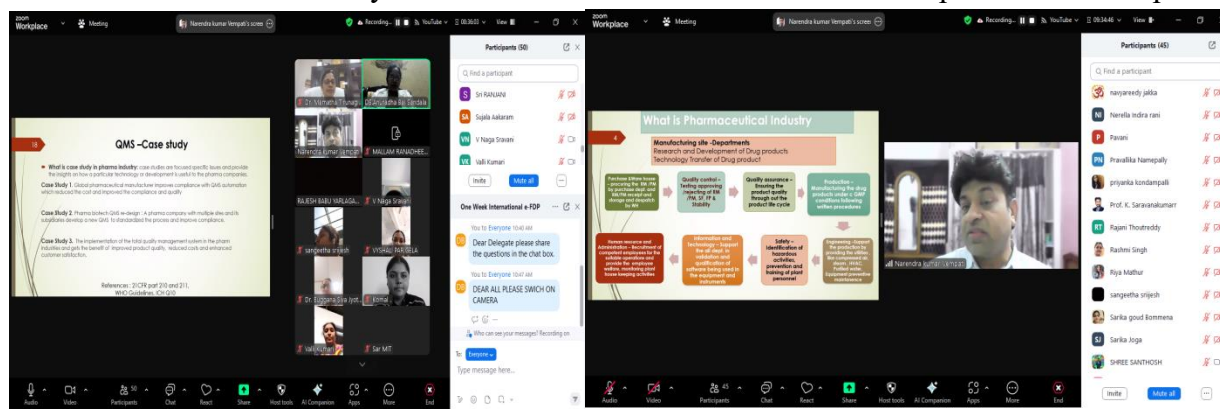
Speaker: Mrs. T. Rajani

Topic: DoE for Optimization in Formulation Development

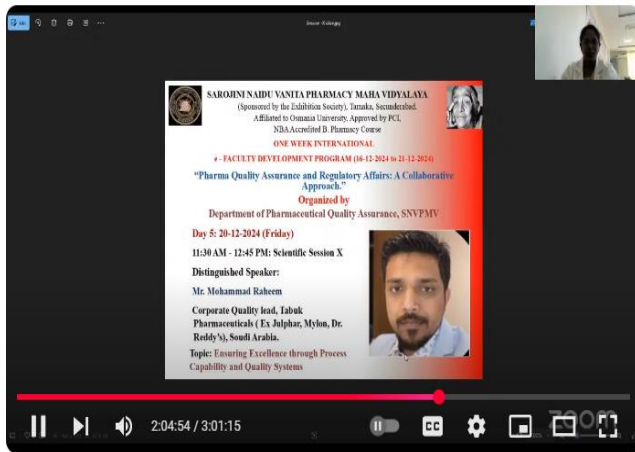
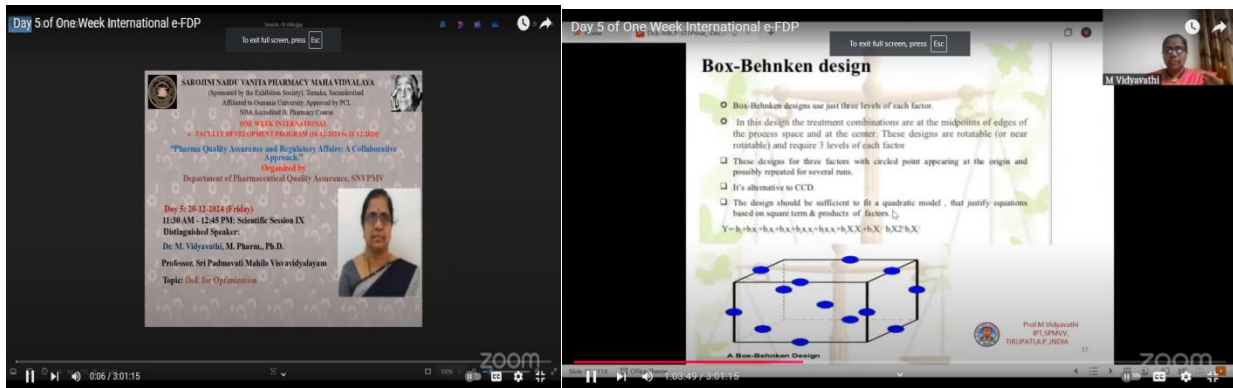

Session X (11:30 AM – 12:45 PM)

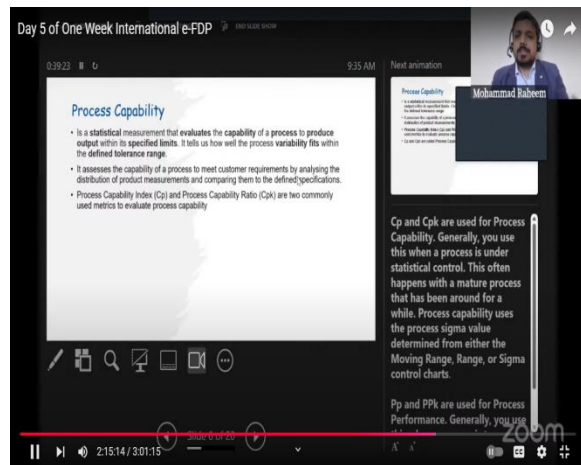
Speaker: Mr. Mohammad Raheem

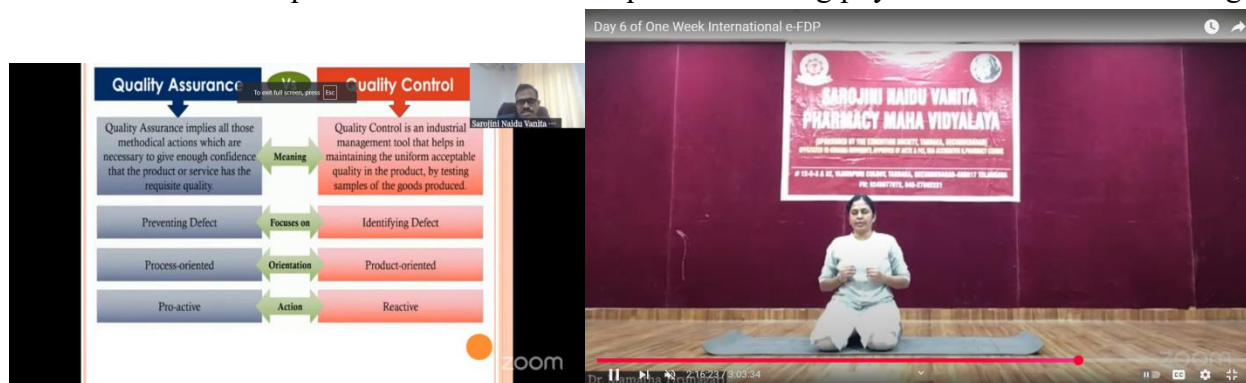
Session XII (11:30 AM – 12:45 PM)

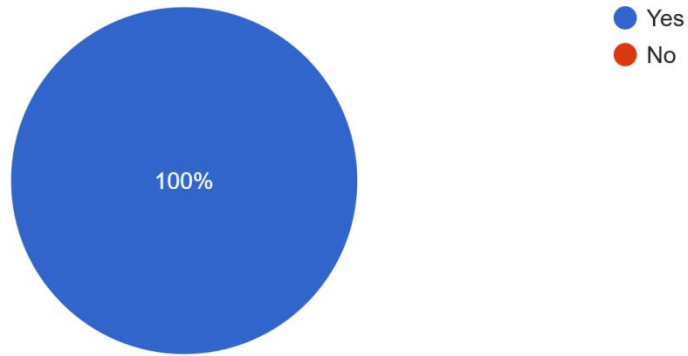

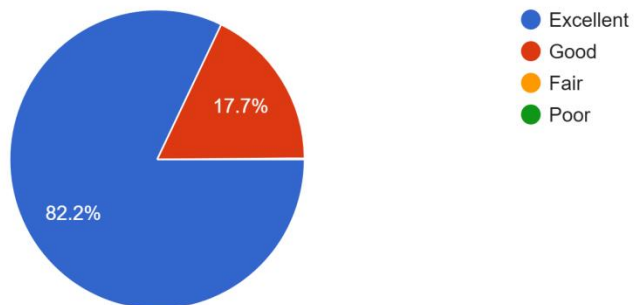
