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## MINUTES OF THE INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL (IQAC) MEETING ON SATURDAY,

23<sup>rd</sup> NOVEMBER 2024 AT 11.30 A.M. IN THE IQAC MEETING HALL OF THE COLLEGE

Dr. N. Srinivas, Chairperson of the IQAC welcomed the Members to the Meeting and requested Dr. P. Vivek Sagar, IQAC Co-Ordinator to take up the agenda. Dr. P. Vivek Sagar has taken up the agenda and invited the Members to participate in the discussion. The following are the resolutions

**Agenda 1: Discuss the status of actionable points from the previous meeting.**

Dr. N. Srinivas, Chairperson has briefed on the NAAC Peer Team inspection which took place on the 7th and 8th of November 2024. He stated that the Peer Team conveyed positive remarks regarding the institution's dedication to quality education, student development, and research.

An intimation has been received that the Standing Committee of NAAC Executive Council in its meeting held on 14.11.2024, has decided on a Re-Visit for our institution. Dr. N. Srinivas, Chairperson presented a brief report on this matter.

- i. Sarojini Naidu Vanita Pharmacy Maha Vidyalaya is not the only College on Re-visit by the NAAC Peer Team and few other colleges were ordered with the revisit of their respective institutions.
- ii. Probably, it is a usual practice for NAAC to Re-visit the colleges seeking accreditation for the first-time and especially when the college is likely to attain a level of A+ Grade.

It was resolved to not get embroiled in the interpretation of what has happened but to wait a bit as we have good DVV scores. If we embark on a positive approach to the re-PTV, we are likely to achieve the desired grade. It was suggested in the meeting that the PTV Revisit is an opportunity to improve further and prepare for the revisit by duly rectifying the shortfalls observed in the first peer team visit.

## **Agenda 2: Strengthening Industry Collaborations and MOUs**

It was resolved to focus on industries that offer advanced technology, research opportunities, and placement assistance. It was proposed to review the terms of existing MOUs and re-negotiate if required. The need to establish new MOUs with emerging industries and start-ups was discussed. Joint research projects with industries are to be encouraged. Departments to submit quarterly reports on industry collaboration activities.

### **Actions:**

A task force comprising faculty members and placement officers was formed to initiate new industry collaborations.

Departments to identify potential industry partners within a month and share the list with the task force.

Departments to organize at least two industry interaction sessions per semester.

## **Agenda 3: Procurement of Advanced Research-Oriented Equipment**

Dr. T. Mamatha, Principal and IQAC member highlighted the growing need for state-of-the-art equipment to facilitate cutting-edge research. Producing advanced equipment would improve research output, attract external funding, and enhance the institution's reputation. It was resolved to take up new R&D projects more aggressively and HODs have to furnish the research protocols and give requirements for advanced equipment if required.

Dr. N. Srinivas, Chairperson suggested that the HODs visit our MOU companies and take feedback on the research-oriented equipment.

## **Agenda 4: Scheduling the three slots for the NAAC peer Team Visit**

Regarding the email dated 22.11.2024 from the NAAC office, regarding the Re-Visit of our institution, it was resolved to propose the following three slots for scheduling the NAAC peer Team Visit:

- **Incentives:** Introduce recognition and incentive schemes to encourage faculty participation in development programs.
- **External Collaborations:** Partner with other institutions and industry experts to provide diverse perspectives and expertise.

**Agenda 1: Discuss the status of actionable points from the previous meeting.**

Dr. N. Srinivas, Chairperson has briefed on the previous meeting and stated that to strengthen our institute we are doing MOUs with new renovated companies and renegotiating the previous MOUs. The IQAC Co-Ordinator started collecting the data required for registering the NIRF portal. Dr. N. Srinivas, Chairperson has briefed on the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) Peer Team visit scheduled on 20th and 21st January 2025 to assess compliance with accreditation criteria.

The Peer Team's revisit involves the institutional presentation by the Principal, Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) presentation by the Director, a presentation by the Placements Officer, and other Departmental/Criteria presentations by the respective HODs/ Senior faculty members. Besides the presentations, the NAAC Peer Team conducts an extensive tour of the campus, inspecting academic, administrative facilities, laboratories, library, and other infrastructure to assess compliance with the NAAC standards.

NAAC Peer Team interacts with various stakeholders such as students, faculty, non-teaching staff, employers and alumni to collect the feedback on institutional strengths and areas for improvement.
