Expert Speaker: Dr. (Col) V.P. Singh

The distinguished guest speaker, Dr. (Col) V.P. Singh, Professor & HOD of Medicine at Bharati Vidyapeeth, Pune, was introduced by Ms. Nikitha, M. Pharmacy I Year student. Dr. Singh, formerly Pro-Vice Chancellor of Sumandeep Vidyapeeth, Gujarat, and Professor of Medicine at the Armed Forces Medical College, Pune, delivered a thought-provoking talk on the influence, challenges, and ethical implications of Artificial Intelligence.

Key Highlights of the Lecture

The Growing Influence of AI

Dr. Singh compared AI to a slow, unnoticed virus subtly shaping human thoughts. He emphasized that AI is not merely assisting us but is gradually manipulating decisions, from travel recommendations to political and social beliefs. He warned that AI-driven algorithms reinforce personal preferences, restricting diverse perspectives and leading to ideological rigidity.

He discussed AI's expansion across industries, from self-driving cars and AI-powered automation to autonomous decision-making. With major investments from tech giants like Microsoft and Google, even small AI innovations—like China's Deep Sea AI—are capable of disrupting billion-dollar industries overnight.

Dr. Singh raised ethical and security concerns, emphasizing that AI is evolving beyond programmed responses to become capable of analyzing, predicting, and learning independently—much like the human brain.

The Ethical Dilemmas and Risks of AI

He cautioned against AI's uncontrolled expansion, highlighting:

- AI-powered assistants influencing human behaviour

- Autonomous military AI systems making critical decisions without human oversight
- AI's potential to develop emotions and autonomy, leading to unpredictable consequences

Referencing films like Steven Spielberg's Artificial Intelligence, he urged the audience to reflect on the future impact of AI and the potential dangers of over-reliance on intelligent machines.

AI: A Double-Edged Sword

Dr. Singh described AI as both a boon and a bane, transforming industries but also raising concerns:

- Precision in robotic surgeries and rapid scientific advancements
- Job displacement and the erosion of human creativity
- AI-driven automation in manufacturing, security, and warfare
- Biases in AI systems affecting hiring, policing, and politics
- AI-generated content questioning the authenticity of human emotions

He warned that over-reliance on AI could turn individuals into passive consumers rather than critical thinkers. While AI enhances productivity, he stressed the need to ensure that human creativity, empathy, and ethics remain paramount.

Engaging Delivery & Poetic Expressions

Dr. Singh captivated the audience with his unique and engaging delivery style, blending humor, anecdotes, and poetry. He emphasized that human touch and compassion matter more than credentials in fields like medicine, where empathy outweighs accolades.

Quoting poetry, he beautifully conveyed the importance of human emotions over artificial intelligence:
