Title of the Invited Talk: Common Skin Diseases and Medical Management

The Department of Pharmacology at Sarojini Naidu Vanita Pharmacy Maha Vidyalaya (SNVPMV), Hyderabad, organized a technical lecture on "Common Skin Diseases and Medical Management". The seminar was led by Dr. Bethi Vijaya Sree, Consultant Dermatologist, Cosmetologist & Trichologist from Medicover Hospital High-tech city Hyderabad.

The initiative was led by **Dr. T. Mamatha**, Principal of SNVPMV, under whose guidance the event was meticulously planned and executed.

The seminar commenced with a welcome address, Eco greetings to dignitaries and prayer song by Rakshitha (Pharm.D IV Yr) and Madhulatha (B.Pharm II Yr). In their addresses, the dignitaries emphasized the importance of dermatological knowledge in pharmaceutical and clinical settings.

The core objective of the seminar was to impart essential clinical insights into **commonly encountered dermatological conditions** along with their **Pharmacological management**. The speaker effectively covered a broad spectrum of skin disorders, enhancing the knowledge of students and professionals alike.

Key topics covered included:

- Acne: Its causes, pathogenesis, and after-effects.
- Eczema: Classification into internal (e.g., atopic, stasis) and external types (e.g., photodermatitis, contact dermatitis), along with genetic, environmental, and dietary triggers.
- **Urticaria:** Characterized by red, itchy welts, and swelling (angioedema), triggered by physical factors, allergens, medications, and autoimmune conditions.
- **Fungal Infections:** Including Tinea (ringworm), Pityriasis versicolor, and candidiasis. Modes of transmission and treatment protocols using topical and systemic antifungals were thoroughly discussed.
- **Folliculitis & Furuncles:** Bacterial and physical causes, presentation as red, pusfilled bumps, and preventive methods including hygiene and shaving techniques.
- **Viral Infections:** Such as herpes simplex, herpes zoster, varicella (chickenpox), and verruca (warts). Emphasis was laid on prevention via vaccination (e.g., HPV, zoster vaccine) and antiviral treatments like acyclovir.
- **Psoriasis:** Chronic inflammatory skin disease with various subtypes like plaque, guttate, and pustular psoriasis, including its triggers and management strategies.
- Other Conditions: Miliaria (heat rash) and sunburns, with a focus on environmental impact and preventive measures.

Visual aids and case images were effectively used throughout the PowerPoint presentation to help student's correlate clinical symptoms with textbook knowledge.

The seminar successfully bridged the gap between theoretical learning and clinical application. The interactive format allowed for active participation from students, with a dedicated Q&A session at the end.
