

A guest lecture on "Immunization for Healthy Ageing" was successfully conducted on 30th April 2025 at Sarojini Naidu Vanita Pharmacy Maha Vidyalaya (SNVPMV), Tarnaka, Secunderabad. The speaker for the session was Dr. Varakala Karishma, a renowned General Physician and Diabetologist.

This inaugural segment laid the foundation for the academic session, emphasizing both intellectual engagement and environmental mindfulness, and created a warm, respectful atmosphere that reflected the ethos of SNVPMV.

Session Introduction

The session was formally inaugurated by **Dr. N. Srinivas**, Director of SNVPMV, who set the tone for the event with an insightful opening address. He introduced the theme of the lecture—"Immunization for Healthy Ageing"—highlighting its critical role in modern preventive healthcare. Dr. Srinivas emphasized that while immunization is often associated with childhood, it remains equally vital across all stages of life, particularly in safeguarding the ageing population from preventable illnesses and complications.

Following this, **Dr. T. Mamatha**, Principal of SNVPMV, and **Dr. B. Haarika**, Vice Principal, addressed the gathering. They underscored the increasing importance of immunization in the context of evolving global health challenges, emerging infectious diseases, and the rising burden of non-communicable diseases. Both dignitaries commended



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the relevance of the topic and encouraged students to explore the scientific and public health dimensions of vaccination.

A student then took the stage to present a succinct yet impactful introduction to the guest speaker, **Dr. Varakala Karishma**. Her professional background as a General Physician and Diabetologist was outlined, with emphasis on her clinical expertise and her ongoing commitment to community health education. The audience was thus well-prepared for the session ahead, with a clear understanding of the speaker's authority and the significance of the subject matter.

"Dr. Varakala Karishma is a dedicated General Physician and Diabetologist with over a decade of clinical experience. She completed her medical education at Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, in 2018 and has been a registered practitioner with the Telangana State Medical Council since the same year. Known for her patient-centered approach and expertise in managing chronic conditions, Dr. Karishma currently practices at Rama Rao and Abhinay Clinic, Hyderabad, where she continues to make a positive impact on community health through her commitment to quality care and preventive medicine."

Lecture Highlights by Dr. Varakala Karishma

Dr. Varakala Karishma delivered a compelling and educational session that delved deeply into the multifaceted topic of immunization as a cornerstone of healthy ageing. Her lecture was meticulously structured to cater to the academic level of the pharmacy students while maintaining clinical relevance.

The key areas covered included:

1. Types of Immunization

Dr. Karishma explained the various categories of immunization applicable at different life stages. She provided a detailed overview of vaccines recommended for:

- ➤ Infants and Toddlers
- School-age Children



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- Adolescents
- ➤ Adults
- Senior Citizens

She highlighted how immunization needs evolve over time and must be tailored to age, medical history, lifestyle, and risk factors.

2. Vaccination Schedules

The speaker elaborated on recommended vaccination timelines, dosage intervals, and the rationale behind booster doses. She clarified the importance of adhering to national immunization schedules and emphasized critical milestones, from birth to late adulthood, where immunizations are most effective and necessary.

3. Benefits of Immunization

A comprehensive discussion was held on the wide-ranging benefits of vaccines, including:

- ➤ Prevention of vaccine-preventable infectious diseases
- > Reduction in hospitalizations and medical complications
- > Enhancement of life expectancy and quality of life
- > Contribution to herd immunity, protecting those unable to be vaccinated

She drew attention to the long-term economic and societal advantages of widespread immunization, especially in aging populations vulnerable to complications.

4. Potential Risks and Considerations

Dr. Karishma addressed common concerns associated with vaccines, including:

- ➤ Mild to rare adverse effects
- > Contraindications and precautions in individuals with allergies or immune disorders
- ➤ Dispelling myths and misconceptions, which often contribute to vaccine hesitancy

She stressed the importance of maintaining personal immunization records and consulting healthcare professionals for accurate guidance.



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5. Specific Vaccines Discussed

The speaker provided detailed insights into various vaccines, such as:

- For Children: BCG, DPT, MMR, Polio, Hepatitis B, and HPV
- ➤ For Adults and Elderly: Influenza, Pneumococcal, Herpes Zoster (Shingles), Tetanus booster, and COVID-19

She explained the indications, administration schedules, and target populations for each, supported by clinical rationale and epidemiological evidence.

6. Special Focus on Lifelong Immunization

A major highlight of the lecture was the emphasis on lifelong immunization. Dr. Karishma advocated for routine vaccine reviews in adulthood, especially for those with chronic illnesses like diabetes, hypertension, and cardiovascular disease. She explained how immunization in these groups not only prevents complications but also supports better disease management and healthier ageing.

Interactive Engagement

The lecture concluded with an engaging Q&A session where students actively participated by posing thoughtful questions. Dr. Karishma answered with clarity, fostering deeper understanding and encouraging critical thinking. The interactive nature of the session reflected the students' keen interest and made the lecture not only informative but also highly impactful.

Felicitation and Conclusion:

At the end of the session, **Dr. T. Mamatha** and **Dr. B. Haarika** felicitated **Dr. Varakala Karishma** with a token of appreciation for her valuable contribution and informative session.
