SEMINAR REPORT

Topic: "Building Future through Employability Skills and Digital Empowerment"

On the occasion of World Youth Skills Day, the Department of Pharmaceutical Chemistry at Sarojini Naidu Vanita Pharmacy Maha Vidyalaya organized a power-packed seminar to empower students with essential employability skills. The event, held on 13th June 2025 at the college auditorium, served as a platform to bridge the gap between academic learning and practical life skills essential for success in the modern world. The seminar was conducted with the vision of creating awareness among youth about the importance of acquiring additional competencies beyond textbook knowledge.

SEMINAR HIGHLIGHTS

The seminar covered an array of essential topics such as:

The PowerPoint presentation designed for the seminar on World Youth Skills Day was rich in content, offering practical insights and skill-building strategies tailored specifically for pharmacy students. The slides effectively addressed both personal and professional development areas, aligning with the seminar's goal to foster holistic growth among students. Below is an elaboration of the key modules presented:

1. Self-Awareness:

This section encouraged students to reflect on their emotions, strengths, weaknesses, and work-life balance. Activities included drawing a 'self-awareness mirror' to answer questions like 'What am I good at?', 'What makes me happy?', and 'What do I want to get better at?'. This exercise was aimed at boosting emotional intelligence and self-confidence.

2. Body Language & Professional Grooming:

Students learned about the role of body language in creating strong first impressions. The trainer highlighted the importance of gestures, posture, eye contact, and hygiene. Dressing appropriately and following grooming standards were shown to have a direct impact on career growth and interpersonal relationships.

3. English Language for Career:

English was presented as a global career tool. Emphasis was placed on using clear, correct language, improving vocabulary, and enhancing both written and verbal communication. Students understood how fluency in English can open doors to promotions, global jobs, and learning resources.

4. Art of Speaking:

The seminar stressed the importance of effective communication—thinking before speaking, choosing simple words, active listening, and maintaining composure during stress. Speaking with clarity and empathy was encouraged as a powerful professional trait.

5. Role of Digital Resources in Pharmacy:

Students were introduced to a range of digital platforms and tools such as Coursera, YouTube, Khan Academy, e-books, online journals, and drug databases like Medscape and Epocrates. These tools help learners stay updated with the latest developments in the pharmaceutical field.

6. AI Tools in Pharmacy:

Al-driven innovations in pharmacy were showcased, including tools like IBM Watson for Drug Discovery, Atomwise for 3D drug modeling, and Al platforms like DeepChem and Medscape. These tools enhance drug research, data analysis, and learning efficiency.

7. Four -Step Process to Get Ready for the Interview:

The four steps—Prepare, Apply, Network, and Perform—were explained with practical examples. The session covered resume writing do's and don'ts, types of resumes (chronological, functional, combination), and video resume tips. Mock interview questions and types of interviews (telephonic, virtual, panel) were also discussed.

A vibrant interactive session followed the presentation where students enthusiastically participated in group activities, shared personal reflections, and responded to a well-designed questionnaire. The session created a safe and inclusive space for students to express themselves. They showed keen interest in AI tools, resume design tips, and practical aspects of interview preparation.




