# Workshop on Prescription Handling and Analysis, Dispensing Practices, Billing Procedures, and Patient Counselling

Date: 5th July 2025

Venue: Model Pharmacy, Sarojini Naidu Vanita Pharmacy Mahavidyalaya

### 1. Introduction and Objective of the Workshop

The Department of Pharm.D organized a one-day interactive and practical workshop on 5th July 2025 to provide experiential learning on core pharmacy practice components. The primary objective was to bridge the gap between academic knowledge and clinical application in areas such as:

- Prescription interpretation and evaluation
- Drug identification and substitution
- Proper dispensing techniques
- Use of pharmacy billing systems
- Effective patient counselling

The target participants were students of Pharm.D 4th year and Post Baccalaureate 1st year.

### 2. Inauguration and Opening Remarks

The workshop commenced with a formal welcome and brief orientation on the significance of prescription handling in real-world pharmacy settings. Faculty members emphasized how such sessions equip students with essential skills to become confident and competent pharmacists.

### 3. Technical Session 1: Understanding Prescriptions

Dr. K. Jithender Sir elaborated on the structure and format of prescriptions. He covered:

- Common prescription abbreviations
- Reading dosage, frequency, route, and duration
- Patient-specific instructions
- Identifying potential red flags

### 4. Technical Session 2: Writing and Identifying Drug Related Problems (DRPs)

Dr. Shivaramakrishna Sir discussed various categories of Drug Related Problems (DRPs), including indication-related, safety-related, and effectiveness-related issues. He explained documentation and the role of pharmacists in patient safety.



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### 5. Hands-On Workshop Activities

Step 1: Reading and Analyzing the Prescription

Each student received a sample prescription and was asked to interpret and identify issues.

Step 2: Drug Identification and Substitution

Students located medicines in the Model Pharmacy and found suitable alternatives when needed.

Step 3: Data Entry and Billing Procedures

With guidance from faculty, students entered drug details into the system and generated bills.

Step 4: Patient Counselling

Students practiced counselling on drug usage, precautions, and adherence using the given prescription.

### 6. Group Interaction and Feedback Session

Students shared their experience and received feedback. Faculty provided additional insights and encouragement.

### 7. Conclusion and Group Photo

The workshop concluded with a group photo, capturing the active participation and enthusiasm of the students.
