The National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit of Sarojini Naidu Vanita Pharmacy Maha Vidyalaya (SNVPMV) successfully conducted the NSS Panel Elections on Saturday, 26th July 2025, in the IQAC Cell of the institution. These elections were conducted to elect a new student panel for the academic year 2025–26 to lead, organize, and manage the various NSS activities and outreach programs in alignment with the objectives of NSS.

Objective of the Elections

After the completion of voting, the counting of votes was done in the presence of observers, and the results were announced on the same day.
