

#### **REPORT ON "MISSION VIKSIT BHARAT - 2047"**

The National Service Scheme (NSS) Unit – I of Sarojini Naidu Vanita Pharmacy Maha Vidyalaya (SNVPMV), Tarnaka organized an informative and inspiring awareness program on "Mission Viksit Bharat - 2047" on the 18th of October, 2025. The session aimed to sensitize and motivate students to actively contribute to the nation's long-term vision of building a developed, self-reliant, and sustainable India by the year 2047, which marks the centenary of India's independence.

#### Vice Principal's Address
