



He spoke passionately about the pharmacy profession, reminding students that while "Vaidyo Narayana Hari" praises the doctor for saving lives, it is the pharmacist who prepares and perfects the medicines — a role equally divine and essential.

He advised students to have faith in themselves, to be disciplined and consistent in their studies, and to avoid comparing themselves with others. Emphasizing that marks are not the true measure of intelligence, he encouraged them to value confidence, curiosity, and perseverance.

To motivate the students, he narrated the inspiring journey of Dr. Radha Vaddavalli, his former Ph.D. student from Bhimavaram. Despite losing her mother to cancer and facing infrastructural limitations, Dr. Radha pursued her research on cancer biology with determination, collaborating with NIN, CCMB, and Hyderabad Central University. Her pioneering work across phytochemistry, microbial antagonism, and computer-aided drug design culminated in significant scientific findings. After earning her Ph.D., she completed postdoctoral research at the Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore, and later continued her career in cancer research in the United States.

Prof. Bhagyanarayana commended her perseverance and urged students to emulate her spirit of resilience and dedication. He concluded by reminding them that their achievements would bring pride not only to themselves but also to their parents, teachers, and the institution.

In his concluding remarks, Sri B. integrity, and holistic student development. He urged the students to embrace discipline, gratitude,


and perseverance as they embark on their academic journey at SNVPMV.
