Activity Overview:

The Fine Arts and Creativity Club organised a bouquet making activity using fresh flowers and leaves as part of its regular club initiatives. The primary aim was to encourage students creativity, improve their aesthetic sense, and prepare attractive floral bouquets to be presented to the NBA inspection committee members visiting the college on the same day.

The activity was jointly organised and actively carried out by B.Pharm and Pharm.D students, who worked in teams to design and assemble the bouquets. Students sat together on the floor, planned their designs, and helped each other with cutting, arranging, and wrapping the flowers, creating a friendly and collaborative atmosphere.

Objectives to provide hands-on experience in basic floral arrangement and bouquet design using fresh materials.

To enhance students creativity, patience, and attention to detail through a structured art-based activity.

To foster teamwork and coordination among B.Pharm and Pharm.D students while preparing bouquets to welcome the NBA inspection guests.

Materials Used: The following materials were used during the session:

- Fresh flowers such as roses, carnations and other seasonal flowers
- Fresh leaves and fillers including palm leaves, foliage and other greens
- Floral foam blocks to support the arrangements
- Transparent wrapping sheets and decorative ribbons for finishing
- Scissors, adhesive tape and rubber bands
- Water and containers to keep the flowers fresh during preparation

Activity Description:

At the start of the session, faculty coordinators briefly explained basic principles of bouquet making, such as colour coordination, height balance, selection of focal flowers and the use of fillers to create a pleasing arrangement. Students were also guided on how to handle flowers gently and how to structure the bouquet so that it looks neat from all sides.

Students then divided themselves into small groups and selected flowers and leaves of their choice to design their own unique bouquets. Using floral foam and wrapping sheets, they cut and arranged the stems, secured them, and finished each bouquet with matching decorative ribbons. Faculty members moved around the groups, offering suggestions and helping students refine the shape and presentation so that the final bouquets would be suitable for formal presentation to the NBA team.

By the end of the session, several attractive bouquets were ready and neatly wrapped. These bouquets were later presented to the NBA inspection members during their visit as a gesture of respect and warm welcome from the college and the Fine Arts and Creativity Club.

Outcomes and Observations:

Students displayed enthusiasm and creativity, experimenting with different combinations of colours, textures and bouquet shapes.

Teamwork between B.Pharm and Pharm.D students was clearly visible, as they shared ideas, divided tasks and supported one another throughout the process. The activity helped improve students confidence, fine motor skills and sense of responsibility, as they were preparing bouquets for an important external inspection team.

Faculty appreciated the quality and presentation of the bouquets, and the NBA visitors received them warmly, which reflected positively on the efforts of the Fine Arts and Creativity Club and the student volunteers.
