The event was conducted in association with Clouds N Codes Technologies to bridge the gap between academic learning and industry requirements in the evolving healthcare IT and medical coding sectors.

6. Key Highlights of the Session

- Training session began with a welcome address delivered by the Director, Dr. N. Srinivas, who underscored the critical need for pharmacy professionals to remain abreast of evolving industry trends. He placed particular emphasis on the growing significance of pharmacovigilance, medical writing, and medical coding in modern healthcare, highlighting their roles in ensuring patient safety, regulatory compliance, and efficient documentation processes.
- Mr. Ravi Kumar, serving as Project Head and a certified trainer, conducted an in-depth session on medical coding and its pivotal importance within the healthcare sector. His presentation covered essential aspects of medical coding, including standardized classification systems like ICD-10, CPT, and HCPCS, which facilitate accurate billing, data analysis, and quality reporting. He elaborated on abundant career opportunities available, such as roles in hospitals, insurance companies, and consulting firms, while outlining key skills required—proficiency in anatomy, coding guidelines, attention to detail, and familiarity with electronic health records (EHR) systems—to succeed in this high-demand field.
- Mr. Krishna, a highly credentialed certified trainer holding certifications in CPC (Certified Professional Coder), CPMA (Certified Professional Medical Auditor), CCS (Certified Coding Specialist), LSSGB (Lean Six Sigma Green Belt), and AI Master, delivered an engaging lecture on pharmacovigilance. He emphasized its foundational role in post-marketing

surveillance for detecting, assessing, and preventing adverse drug reactions, alongside the value of allied fields such as medical billing and SAS (Statistical Analysis System) programming. Mr. Krishna detailed promising career opportunities, including positions as drug safety associates, pharmacovigilance scientists, and regulatory affairs specialists in pharmaceutical companies and CROs, stressing the need for analytical skills, regulatory knowledge, and data management expertise.

- Mr. Nagarajesh P presented an insightful lecture that focused on the dynamic landscape of emerging sectors within healthcare. He highlighted the rapid expansion of the Healthcare IT sector, particularly in medical coding, medical billing, and pharmacovigilance, driven by digital transformation, regulatory mandates, and global outsourcing trends. On career scope, he provided a detailed explanation of job profiles tailored for pharmacy graduates, including medical coders, clinical data analysts, and pharmacovigilance officers working in US healthcare processes and Clinical Research Organizations (CROs), noting competitive salaries, remote work options, and international exposure. Finally, he outlined the importance of key certifications like CPC for professional validation, alongside essential technical proficiencies such as coding software mastery, data analytics tools, HIPAA compliance understanding, and soft skills like problem-solving to excel in these competitive domains. He presented data on the increasing demand for life science graduates in the corporate healthcare sector, moving beyond traditional production and marketing roles.

The session was interactive, with students asking questions regarding salary packages, growth hierarchy, and training duration required for these specific roles.

Following the informative sessions, Sakunthala, HR Executive, and Supriya, Senior HR Operations Lead from Clouds N Codes Technologies, conducted an engaging group discussion. They announced an opportunity to provide free coaching to five meritorious students selected through this interactive evaluation. Students actively participated with enthusiasm, showcasing their understanding of medical coding, pharmacovigilance, and healthcare IT concepts discussed during the expert lectures. This practical assessment not only helped identify top performers for the training program but also gave participants valuable experience in group discussion skills essential for healthcare industry interviews.

options beyond traditional lab work.

Students gained a understanding of alternative career paths outside wet-lab roles. They learned about high-demand jobs in medical coding, Pharmacovigilance, medical billing, and healthcare IT. These opportunities exist in US healthcare systems and Clinical Research Organizations (CROs), offering stable employment with good growth potential. Out of 17 students, 5 students were selected for free training in any one selected course.

Training and Certification Awareness

Participants discovered exactly what training is needed to break into these fields. Key certifications highlighted include CPC (Certified Professional Coder), CPMA, and CCS. Essential skills covered coding systems like ICD-10 and CPT, SAS programming, HIPAA compliance, and data analytics tools. Students now know the specific steps required to become job-ready.

Networking Opportunities

The event created valuable connections between students and industry professionals from Clouds N Codes Technologies. Expert speakers Mr. Ravi Kumar, Mr. Krishna, and Mr. Nagarajesh P interacted directly with attendees. This opened doors for mentorship, internship possibilities, and future job opportunities in these growing sectors.
