### **Building High-Quality Institutional Patent Applications that Withstand Examination**

**Name of the Speaker:** Mr. Srinivas Maddipati, IPR Attorney

The Department of Pharmaceutical Quality Assurance & IPR Cell, Sarojini Naidu Vanita Pharmacy Maha Vidyalaya (SNVPMV), organized a seminar on 18th February 2026 at 3:00 PM in the Seminar Hall on the topic “***Building High-Quality Institutional Patent Applications that Withstand Examination.***”

The programme aimed to create awareness among students and faculty about patent, drafting, filing procedures, legal compliance under the Indian Patents Act, and the importance of developing strong institutional patent applications capable of withstanding examination and prosecution.

Mr. Srinivas Maddipati began the lecture with an overview of Intellectual Property Rights, covering:

- Patents
- Copyrights
- Trademarks
- Geographical Indications
- Industrial Designs
- Trade Secrets

He explained the legal framework governing patents in India and elaborated on the **Patent Filing Process**, including:

- Filing of Patent Application
- Date of Priority
- Request for Examination (RFE)
- Examination Process
- Prosecution and Compliance

Core Components of a Patent Application

The speaker provided detailed guidance on drafting essential elements of a patent application. Special emphasis was placed on drafting strong and precise claims, as they determine the scope of patent protection.

### Provisional and Complete Specifications

Mr. Maddipati explained:

#### Provisional Specification:

- Filed to secure priority date
- Used when invention is not fully complete
- Complete specification must be filed within 12 months

#### Complete Specification:

- Must comply with Section 10 of the Patents Act
- Contains full disclosure and claims
- Non-filing within prescribed time results in abandonment

### Mandatory Forms in Patent Filing

The speaker elaborated on statutory forms required for filing:

- Form 1 – Application for Grant of Patent
- Form 2 – Provisional/Complete Specification
- Form 3 – Statement regarding foreign applications
- Form 4 – Extension of time
- Form 18 – Request for Examination

Timelines, fee structures, and compliance requirements were clearly explained.

#### **What Cannot Be Patented**

The speaker highlighted Sections 3 and 4 of the Indian Patents Act, including:

- Section 3(c): Discoveries not patentable
- Section 3(i): Medical and surgical methods not patentable

He clarified common misconceptions regarding patent eligibility.

#### **Interactive Session**

An engaging question-and-answer session followed, where students and faculty members raised queries related to:

- Under Indian patent law, what are the most common reasons an applications get rejected and if it is a minor mistake
- Patentability criteria
- Claim drafting techniques
- Institutional ownership of patents
- Filing timelines and prosecution challenges

The speaker provided practical insights and real-world examples to address these queries.

#### **Conclusion**

The seminar successfully provided in-depth knowledge on patent drafting, filing procedures, and IPR laws. It emphasized the importance of preparing high-quality, examination-ready patent applications and encouraged students to actively participate in research and innovation activities. The session strengthened participant's understanding of legal compliance, documentation standards, and institutional patent management practices.


