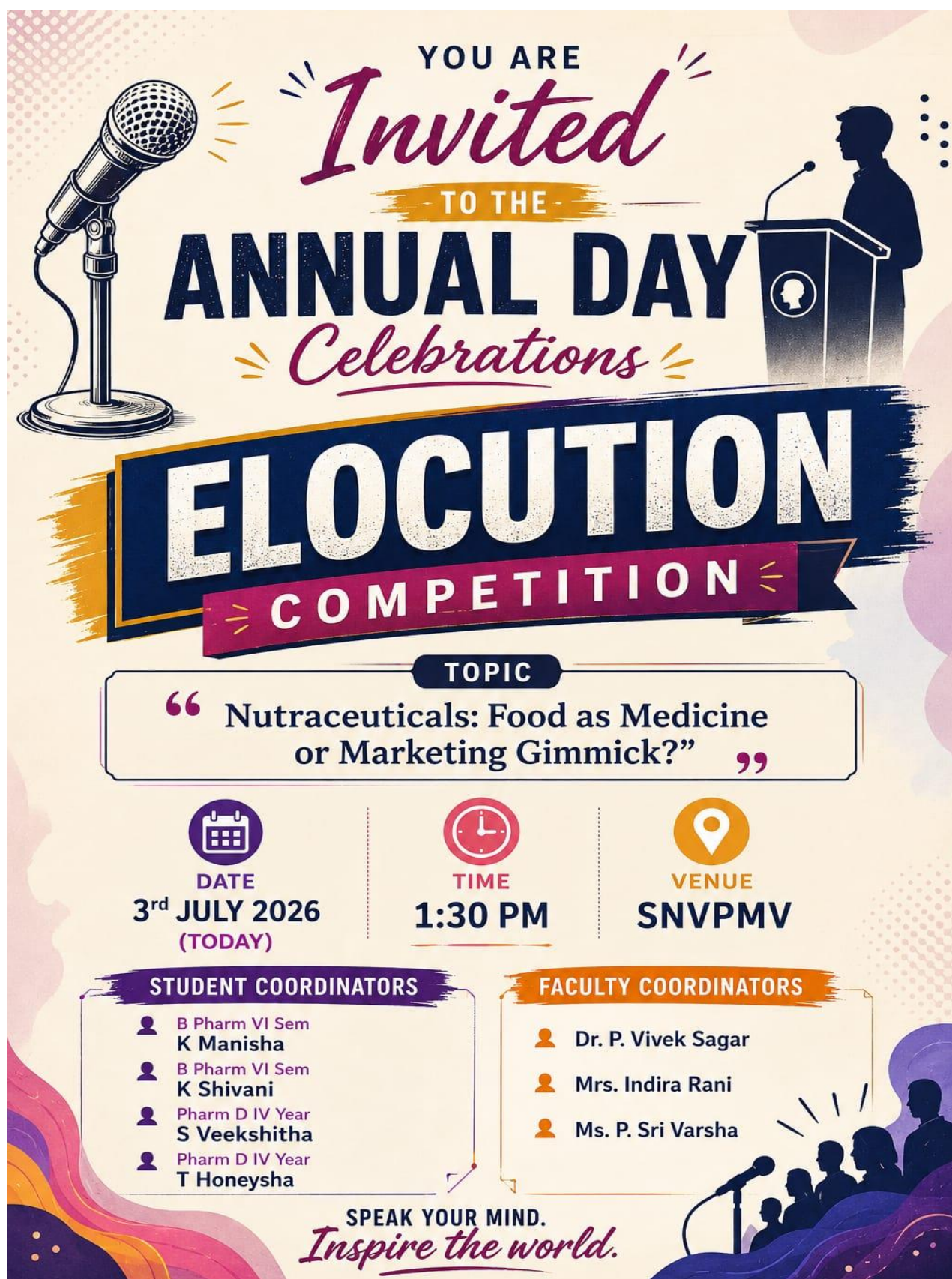

Impact and Outcomes:

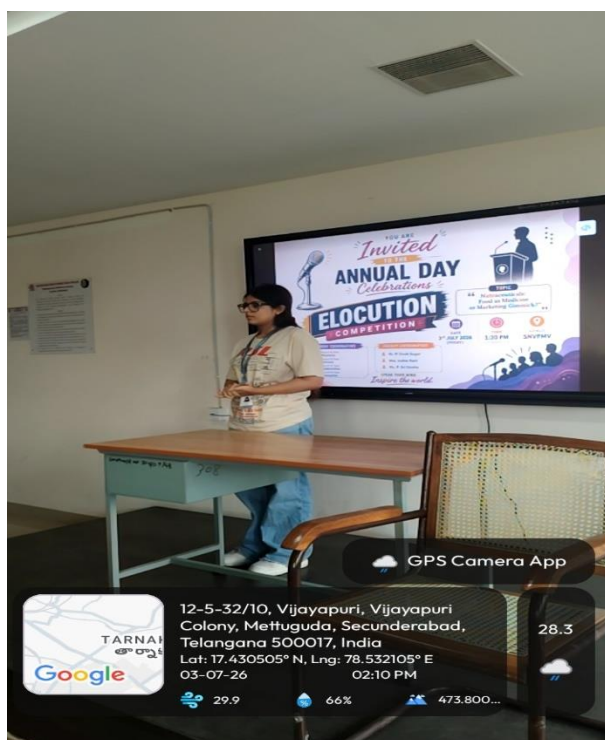
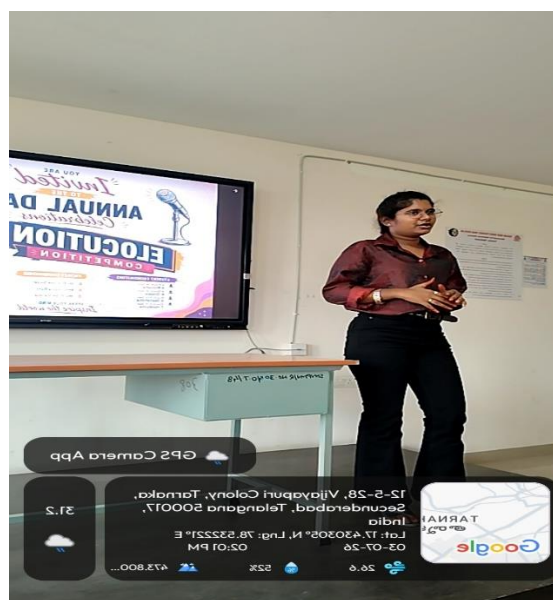
