MINUTES OF ANTI-RAGGING COMMITTEE MEETING

Date: 11 June 2026

Time: 12:00 PM – 1:15 PM

Venue: Board Room, SNVPMV

Minute-to-Minute Proceedings

1. Welcome Address

The meeting commenced with a welcome address by Dr. T. Mamatha, Principal, SNVPMV who emphasized the institution's commitment towards maintaining a ragging-free campus and ensuring strict compliance with UGC Anti-Ragging Regulations.

2. Introduction of Members

All committee members introduced themselves. The committee reviewed the existing composition of the Anti-Ragging Committee and Anti-Ragging Squad.

3. Agenda Presentation

Dr. S Hemalatha, Secretary, Anti-Ragging Committee and Anti-Ragging Squad, presented the agenda of the meeting and briefed the members on the objectives and responsibilities of the committee.

4. Inclusion of New Members

The committee approved the inclusion of newly nominated student representatives:

- B. Sneha – Pharm.D 2nd Year
- T. Madhuri – Pharm.D 3rd Year
- K. Jose Solomon – B.Pharm 2nd Semester
- Juwairiyah – Pharm.D 4th Year
- K. Satya Sri – M.Pharm 1st Year (Pharmacology)
- P. Abhishek Goud – M.Pharm 1st Year (QA)
- Pooja D – Pharm.D 2nd Year

The Secretary was instructed to update the official committee records.

5. Anti-Ragging Squad Responsibilities

It was discussed that the Anti-Ragging Squad shall function independently and conduct surprise inspections in classrooms, corridors, hostels, canteen areas, and other student gathering locations.

6. Suggestions and Recommendations

The committee considered valuable inputs received from **Sri Hanumanth Rao, Secretary**, and **Sri Chandrajeet Singh, Joint Secretary**, regarding the strengthening of anti-ragging measures within the institution. Their recommendations included:

- Display of Anti-Ragging Committee member details and helpline information through QR codes and notice boards on every floor.
- Establishment of dedicated email IDs for the receipt of complaints and grievances.
- Development of a standardized complaint submission form to facilitate systematic reporting and documentation.
- Adoption of measures aimed at fostering a healthy, friendly, and inclusive campus environment for all students.

The committee appreciated these recommendations and resolved to take appropriate steps for their implementation.

7. Committee Composition and Constitution

The committee discussed the constitution and strengthening of the Anti-Ragging Committee in accordance with UGC Anti-Ragging Regulations. Based on the recommendations received from Sri **Hanumanth Rao, Secretary**, and Sri **Chandrajeet Singh, Joint Secretary**, it was resolved to reconstitute and frame the committee with the inclusion and collaboration of the following stakeholders:

- Parent Representatives
 - Police Representatives (where applicable)
 - External Members as per UGC guidelines
8. The committee further resolved that the participation of these stakeholders would enhance transparency, accountability, and effective implementation of anti-ragging measures within the institution. Any changes in Student Representatives during the academic year shall not affect the continuity and functioning of the committee.

9. Awareness and Induction Programs

Members discussed conducting anti-ragging awareness sessions during student induction programs every academic year.

10. Display of Anti-Ragging Information

The committee resolved to display:

- Names and contact details of committee members
- Complaint reporting procedures
- Disciplinary actions and penalties
- Anti-Ragging helpline details on every floor and institutional notice boards.

11. Complaint Reporting Mechanism

The committee discussed:

- Standard reporting procedures
- Documentation of incidents
- Escalation mechanisms
- Maintenance of records and reports

A dedicated Anti-Ragging email ID was proposed for receiving complaints and grievances.

12. Quarterly Review Meetings and Conclusion

The committee decided that:

- Awareness campaigns shall be conducted periodically.
- Anti-Ragging Committee review meetings shall be conducted quarterly.
- Reports shall be submitted to the principal for necessary action.

13. Deliberations and Recommendations

Prior to the Vote of Thanks, Sri **Hanumanth Rao, Secretary**, and Sri **Chandrajeet Singh, Joint Secretary**, shared their observations and recommendations regarding the effective

implementation of anti-ragging measures within the institution. They emphasized the importance of creating a safe, welcoming, and student-friendly campus environment and suggested the following:

- Wider dissemination of Anti-Ragging Committee member details and contact information across all floors of the institution.
- Display of Anti-Ragging Helpline numbers and grievance redressal procedures at prominent locations.
- Establishment of a dedicated institutional email ID for reporting ragging-related complaints and concerns.
- Development of a structured complaint registration form to facilitate timely reporting and proper documentation.
- Strengthening awareness initiatives to encourage students to report incidents without fear and to promote mutual respect among students.

The committee took note of these recommendations and agreed to incorporate them into its action plan.

14. Resolutions Passed

After detailed deliberations, the committee unanimously resolved to:

- Approved the Reconstitution of Anti-Ragging Committee as per the UGC guidelines. For this purpose, the institution will actively proceed with searching for and nominating representatives from the Police, Media, Civil administration, and NGOs, in addition to parent representatives, to fulfil the mandatory statutory composition.
- Constitute the Anti-Ragging Committee with representation from parents, police authorities (where applicable), and external members in accordance with UGC regulations.
- Organize Anti-Ragging awareness and sensitization programs during student induction and at regular intervals throughout the academic year.
- Ensure the display of Anti-Ragging Committee details, helpline numbers, reporting procedures, and disciplinary provisions on all floors and institutional notice boards.
- Create a dedicated email ID for receiving and addressing anti-ragging complaints and grievances.
- Develop a formal complaint reporting mechanism, including a complaint submission form and maintenance of relevant records.
- Foster a culture of mutual respect, inclusiveness, and student well-being through continuous awareness and preventive measures

15. Vote of Thanks

The meeting concluded with a Vote of Thanks delivered by **Dr. S Hemalatha Madam, Secretary** of Anti-Ragging Committee, who expressed her sincere gratitude to the Chairperson, Secretary, Joint Secretary, committee members, faculty members, teaching and non-teaching staff, student representatives, and all attendees for their active participation, valuable suggestions, and continued support in fostering a safe, inclusive, and ragging-free campus environment.
