## Report

As part of the Annual Day Celebrations 2026, the Department organized a **Debate Competition** to promote analytical thinking, logical reasoning, teamwork, and effective communication among students. The finalists presented well-structured arguments supported by relevant examples and demonstrated excellent teamwork and confidence. The judges appreciated the participants for their critical thinking, clarity of expression, rebuttal skills, and stage presence.

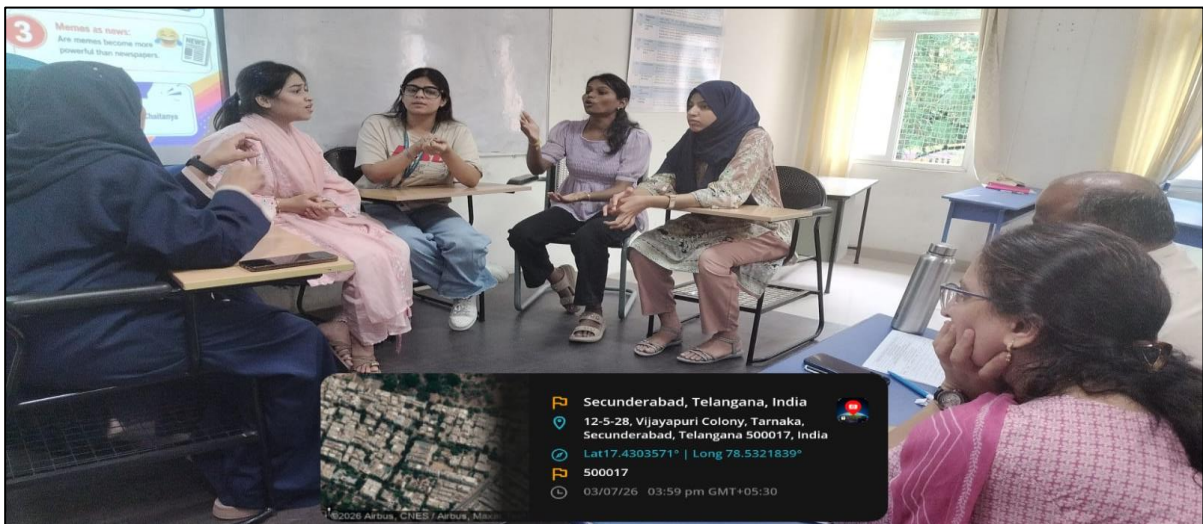
