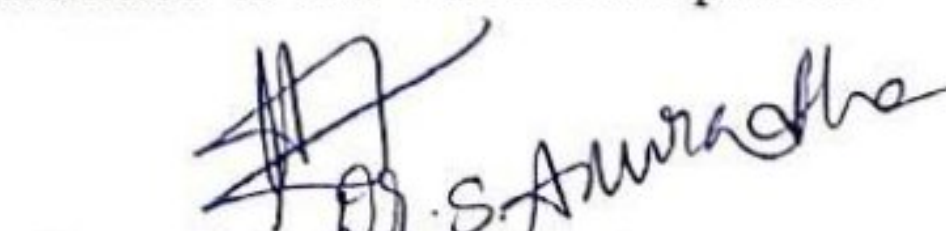

The topic is highly relevant to the present digital environment, where cybercrime, online fraud, identity theft, phishing, financial scams, password theft, social-media threats, and other digital risks are increasing rapidly. Cybersecurity awareness is essential for students and staff to ensure safe, secure, and responsible use of digital technologies.
2. The session addresses current technological and societal needs, particularly the increasing use of online banking, digital payments, social media, mobile applications, email, e-commerce, and other internet-based services. The programme aims to create awareness about common cyber threats, preventive measures, and responsible digital behaviour.
3. The target participants include students, teaching staff, non-teaching staff, and other members of the institution. The session aims to improve awareness of cyber safety, digital privacy, secure online practices, and appropriate responses to cyber incidents. Approximately 200 participants are expected to benefit.
4. The awareness session is scheduled as per the Institutional Calendar from 2:30 PM onwards at the SNVPMV Auditorium. The programme is planned as a focused awareness activity and is not expected to significantly affect the regular academic schedule.
5. The resource person, Mr. Navatheja Nammi, is a renowned Cyber Security Awareness Trainer with expertise in cybercrime, digital safety, online fraud prevention, social-media security, and responsible use of digital platforms. His practical approach will help participants understand real-life cyber threats and their prevention.
6. The session aims to create awareness about common cybercrime and online fraud, educate participants on phishing, identity theft, password security, financial scams, and social-media threats, promote safe use of digital platforms, and provide practical knowledge to identify, prevent, and appropriately respond to cyber incidents.
7. The programme will help participants understand common cybercrimes and online scams and learn practical measures to protect personal information, passwords, financial details, and digital identities. It will also strengthen the institution's culture of cybersecurity awareness and responsible digital citizenship, enabling participants to recognize suspicious links, messages, calls, applications, and online transactions.
8. A brief one-page report of the awareness session will be submitted to the Vice-Principal for institutional documentation and record.

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REPORT ON CYBER CRIME AWARENESS SESSION

Date: 18th August 2026 (Tuesday)

Time: 2:30 P.M. onwards

Venue: SNVPMV Auditorium

Organized by: Sarojini Naidu Vanita Pharmacy Maha Vidyalaya (Co-Ed.)

Number of Participants: Approximately 200

Sarojini Naidu Vanita Pharmacy Maha Vidyalaya (Co-Ed.), Hyderabad, organized a Cyber Crime Awareness Session on 18th August 2026 at the SNVPMV Auditorium to create awareness among students, faculty members, and staff about the increasing risks associated with cybercrime, online fraud, phishing, identity theft, financial scams, social-media threats, and unsafe digital practices. The session focused on promoting responsible digital behaviour and equipping participants with practical knowledge to protect themselves from cyber threats.

The session was conducted with the objective of addressing the growing dependence on smartphones, social media, online banking, digital payments, email, mobile applications, and other internet-based services. The programme emphasized the importance of cybersecurity awareness as an essential component of responsible digital citizenship.

The programme was conducted in the gracious presence of Dr. B. Prabha Shankar, Chairman, SNVPMV (Co-Ed.), Sri B. Hanumanth Rao, Hon. Secretary, Dr. N. Srinivas, Director (CAA&P), Dr. B. Haarika, Principal, Dr. K. Neelima, Vice-Principal, Dr. N.V.N. Charyulu, Retd. Principal and Ex-Secretary, Exhibition Society, faculty members, staff, and students.

WELCOME ADDRESS

Dr. B. Prabha Shankar, Chairman, SNVPMV (Co-Ed.), delivered the Welcome Address and welcomed the dignitaries, resource person, faculty members, staff, and students. He highlighted the increasing importance of cybersecurity awareness in the present digital era and emphasized the need for students and staff to remain vigilant while using online services, digital payments, social media, and mobile applications. He encouraged all participants to make safe and responsible use of technology and to remain alert against emerging cyber threats.

SPECIAL ADDRESS

Dr. N.V.N. Charyulu, Retired Principal and Ex-Secretary of the Exhibition Society, addressed the gathering and spoke about the significance of conducting cyber crime awareness programmes in educational institutions. He emphasized that cyber safety is not only a technical concern but also a matter of personal responsibility, awareness, and disciplined digital behaviour. He advised students and staff to exercise caution while sharing



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personal information online, responding to unknown communications, accessing links, and carrying out digital financial transactions.

OBJECTIVES OF THE CYBER CRIME AWARENESS SESSION

- To create awareness about different forms of cybercrime and online fraud.
- To educate students and staff about phishing, identity theft, financial scams, cyberbullying, and social-media-related threats.
- To promote safe use of passwords, two-factor authentication, digital payments, email, smartphones, and social-media platforms.
- To develop the ability to identify suspicious links, messages, calls, websites, applications, and online transactions.
- To encourage responsible digital citizenship and appropriate reporting of cyber incidents.

GUEST SPEAKER SESSION

Mr. Navatheja Nammi, Renowned Cyber Security Awareness Trainer, delivered an informative and practical session on cybercrime awareness. He explained the changing nature of cyber threats and discussed how cybercriminals use technology, social engineering, fraudulent communications, fake websites, malicious links, and deceptive calls or messages to target individuals.

The speaker discussed common forms of cybercrime and online fraud, including phishing, OTP and banking frauds, identity theft, social-media scams, fake customer-care calls, fraudulent links and applications, password-related attacks, and misuse of personal information. He emphasized that cybercriminals often exploit human behaviour and lack of awareness rather than relying only on sophisticated technology.

Mr. Navatheja Nammi also explained practical preventive measures such as creating strong and unique passwords, enabling two-factor authentication, avoiding the sharing of OTPs and PINs, verifying unknown links and callers, maintaining privacy on social-media platforms, updating devices and applications, using secure networks, and exercising caution while making digital payments. Participants were advised not to click on suspicious links or download applications from untrusted sources.

The session also highlighted the importance of immediate action after a suspected cyber incident. Participants were encouraged to preserve relevant evidence, inform the concerned bank or service provider in cases of financial fraud, and report cyber incidents through appropriate official channels. Real-life examples and practical situations made the session engaging and helped participants understand how easily common cyber scams can occur in everyday life.



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IMPACT OF THE CYBER CRIME AWARENESS SESSION

- Enhanced participants' understanding of cybercrime, online fraud, and digital security threats.
- Improved awareness regarding phishing, identity theft, financial scams, social-media threats, and fraudulent communications.
- Developed practical knowledge about protecting passwords, OTPs, personal information, financial details, and digital identity.
- Encouraged responsible and safe use of smartphones, social media, online banking, and digital payment platforms.
- Strengthened the culture of cybersecurity awareness and responsible digital citizenship within the institution.

OUTCOMES OF THE CYBER CRIME AWARENESS SESSION

- Participants developed a clear understanding of common cybercrimes and online scams.
- Students and staff learned practical measures for preventing cyber fraud and protecting personal information.
- Participants became better equipped to identify suspicious emails, messages, links, calls, websites, and applications.
- Awareness was enhanced regarding safe digital payments, password management, privacy settings, and two-factor authentication.
- Participants were motivated to adopt responsible digital practices and report cyber incidents promptly.

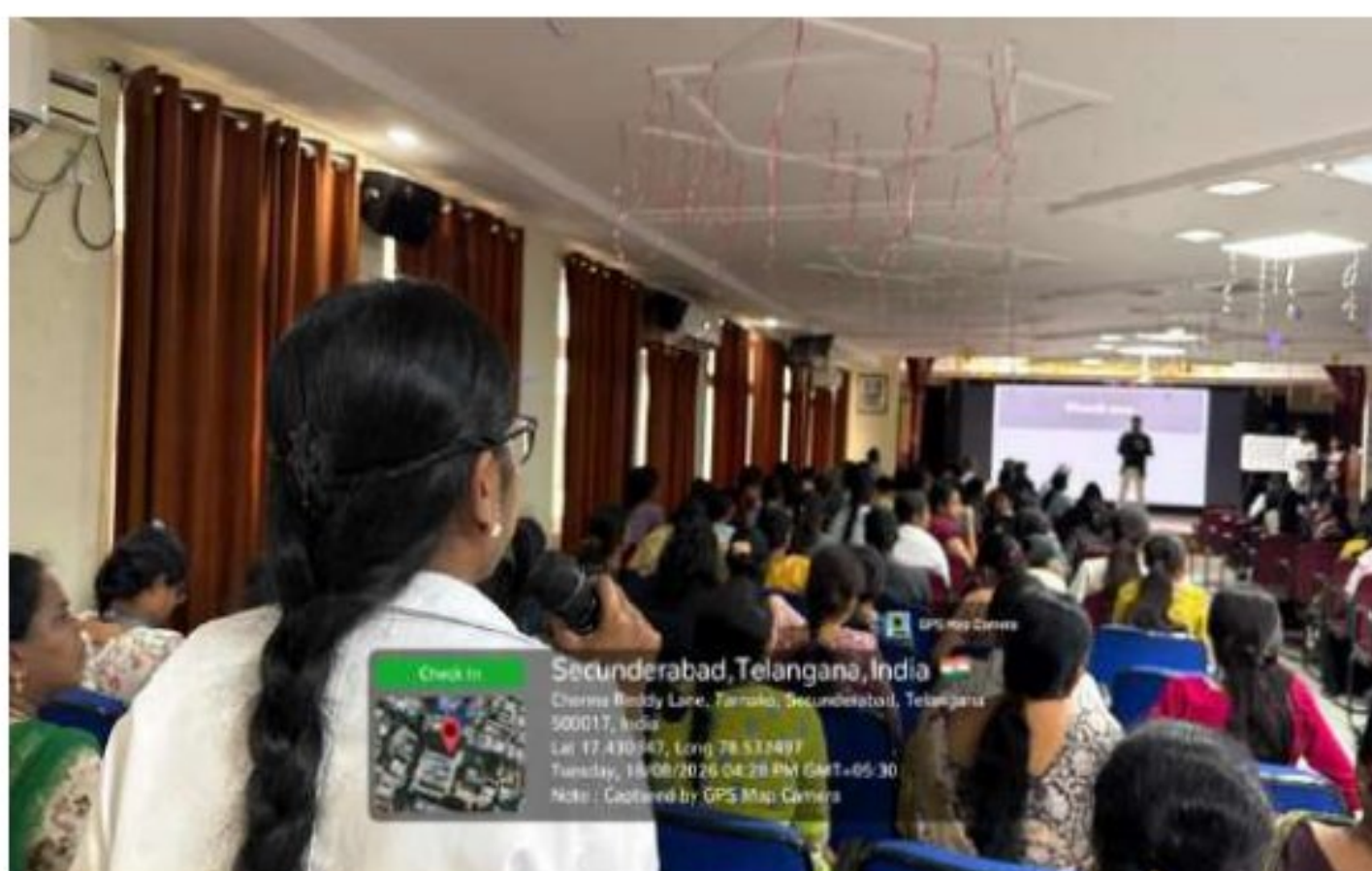
