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REPORT ON “HAR GHAR TIRANGA” CAMPAIGN 2026

Organized by NSS Unit – Sarojini Naidu Vanita Pharmacy Maha Vidyalaya (Co-Ed.)
Tarnaka, Hyderabad

1. Introduction

The NSS Unit of Sarojini Naidu Vanita Pharmacy Maha Vidyalaya (SNVPMV) organized a series of activities under the “Har Ghar Tiranga” Campaign 2026 to promote patriotism, national unity, respect for the National Flag, and awareness about India's rich history and freedom movement.

The programme was conducted as a three-day series of activities on **12th August 2026, 13th August 2026, and 15th August 2026**, involving NSS volunteers, school students, faculty members, and the institutional NSS team.

The initiative was particularly designed to connect the spirit of Independence Day with the younger generation and to encourage students to understand that the National Flag represents the sacrifices, unity, dignity, and aspirations of the nation.

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4. Day-wise Activities

DAY 1 – 12th August 2026

Har Ghar Tiranga Awareness Programme

Upper Primary School, Pedda Golconda

The first phase of the Har Ghar Tiranga campaign was conducted on **12th August 2026 at Upper Primary School, Pedda Golconda.**

The NSS team from SNVPMV interacted with the school students and created awareness regarding the importance of Independence Day, the National Flag, patriotism, and responsible citizenship.

The programme provided an opportunity for NSS volunteers and school students to exchange ideas and understand the importance of celebrating Independence Day beyond ceremonial activities.

Address by NSS Programme Officer

Mr. D. Suresh, NSS Programme Officer, SNVPMV, addressed the students and shared his insights on the **Har Ghar Tiranga campaign.**
